<u>3772</u> ouranós – heaven (singular), and nearly as often used in the plural ("heavens"). "The singular and plural have distinct overtones and therefore should be distinguished in translation (though unfortunately they rarely are)" (G. Archer)

There is just but one way there and that is through the Son of God our Lord Jesus Christ (Matthew 25:31-46, Luke 23:43, John 14:6). He has been given all authority in heaven and on

earth (Matthew 28:18-20), and there are no doctrines, commands, or rules (Matthew 15:3, Matthew 15:9, Colossians 2:20-22, Titus 1:14, 1 John 2:4) that have been created by man no matter how sincere or compassionate they might sound they will not bring you home to God our Father, the Son of God and the Holy Spirit into the new heavens and new earth (Isaiah 65:17, 2 Peter 3:10-13, Revelation 21:1-6).

There are many false beliefs and false teachings that are in these self-made religions that are called Christian denominational churches, or independent, or community or city churches, any mosques, any Jewish synagogues, any or Jewish temples, any Hinduism, Buddhism, Sikhism temples, any Zoroastrianism (whose temples are sometimes called Agiary), the Baha'i Faith (which are often simply referred to as Baha'i House of Worship), Taoism (which are sometimes called Daoguan), Shinto (which are sometimes called Jinja), Confucianism (which are sometimes called the Temple of Confucius), and ancient religions such as the Ancient Egyptian religion, or any Pagan places of their rituals, any palaces, any ministries, and individuals preaching that they can guide you to Paradise or Heaven, they cannot! The truth be told they are blind guides guiding you to condemnation in Hell to eternal torment and agony.

There is only one true church (the body) of the Lord Christ Jesus (<u>John 14:6</u>, <u>Romans 16:16</u>, <u>Colossians 1:17-20</u>) and that church is made up of the faithful baptized believers that seek the eternal kingdom of God and Christ (<u>Acts 8:12</u>, <u>Acts 28:31</u>, <u>Ephesians 5:5</u>, <u>Colossians 1:13-15</u>, <u>2 Timothy 4:1</u>, <u>2 Peter 1:3-11</u>, <u>Revelation 11:15</u>, <u>Revelation 12:10</u>).

These are just but some of the scriptural references from God's Son our Lord Jesus Christ (Matthew 7:24-27, Matthew 16:18, Matthew 11:28-30, Matthew 28:18-20, Mark 16:15-16, John 15:1-12, Hebrews 1:1-14) and the Lord's Apostles (Acts 1:1-8, Acts 2:42, Romans 1:1-6), the Hebrews writer (Hebrews 3:12-14, Hebrews 10:19-25 NASB), and the Lord's brothers James and Jude (Matthew 13:55 NASB 1 Corinthians 9:5, James 1:1, Jude 1:1) has been given us along with His Apostles and His brothers James and Jude His words, teachings, and commandments for us to obey and follow (Matthew 7:24-27, Matthew 28:18-20, Mark 4:10-25, John 14:15-24, Acts 2:41-42, Romans 12:3-21, Romans 13:1-14, Philippians 2:1-11, Titus 3:1, James 1:1-10, 1 Peter 1:13-20, 1 Peter 2:13-15, 2 Peter 3:1-14, 1 John 1:1-10, Jude 1:1-25 NASB) for our salvation.

God our Father through His Son and the Holy Spirit have given us their word of truth in the written inspired word of God (<u>John 8:31-32</u>, <u>John 1:14-17</u>, <u>John 14:6</u>, <u>John 17:17</u>, <u>2 Corinthians 5:1</u>, <u>2 Corinthians 12:3-4</u>, <u>Ephesians 1:13</u>, <u>2 Timothy 3:16 NASB</u>, <u>1 John 5:20</u>) for us to be able to go to paradise and then unto heaven (<u>Revelation 2:7 ASV</u>).
