## **Corvette Cruisers of Illinois**

### **'Mostly' Honorable Roadkill Traveling Trophy**

- 1. The trophy must be prominently displayed in the recipient's home — ideally on the fireplace mantle for all visitors to admire.***
- 2. The trophy remains in the recipient's custody until the Club's annual Christmas Party, where it will be formally transferred to the next honoree.***
- 3. The trophy must be kept in good condition. Tasteful decorations or humorous embellishments are permitted as long as the trophy remains recognizable.***

4. Each recipient must add a brief written account of their “roadkill moment” to the official Roadkill Logbook.

5. Members may not intentionally create a qualifying incident to win the trophy. (If you try, you will still ‘win’ – but everyone will know why.)

6. Eligible incidents include wildlife encounters, garage mishaps, parking errors, trailer-loading fails, and any event causing fellow Cruisers to say, “Oof... that’s gonna leave a mark.”

7. Any club member may submit nominations, ideally with photos or eyewitness testimonies.

8. Recipients must accept the honor with gratitude, humility, humor and good sportsmanship.

9. The trophy must be returned at the annual Christmas Party in display-ready condition.
