### 'Mostly' Honorable Roadkill Traveling Trophy

- 1. The trophy must be prominently displayed in the recipient's home ideally on the fireplace mantle for all visitors to admire.
- 2. The trophy remains in the recipient's custody until the Club's annual Christmas Party, where it will be formally transferred to the next honoree.
- 3. The trophy must be kept in good condition. Tasteful decorations or humorous embellishments are permitted as long as the trophy remains recognizable.

- 4. Each recipient must add a brief written account of their "roadkill moment" to the official Roadkill Logbook.
- 5. Members may not intentionally create a qualifying incident to win the trophy. (If you try, you will still 'win' but everyone will know why.)
- 6. Eligible incidents include wildlife encounters, garage mishaps, parking errors, trailer-loading fails, and any event causing fellow Cruisers to say, "Oof... that's gonna leave a mark."
- 7. Any club member may submit nominations, ideally with photos or eyewitness testimonies.
- 8. Recipients must accept the honor with gratitude, humility, humor and good sportsmanship.
- 9. The trophy must be returned at the annual Christmas Party in display-ready condition.
