

COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN
Surfside Beach Marathon – Stahlman Park Pavilion
February 12-13, 2021

A conscious effort will be made to observe guidelines for social distancing as set forth by the Texas Department of State Health Services for Outdoor Events as posted on July 3, 2020.

Registration:

Participants will be encouraged to pre-register on their own devices prior to packet pickup. Online registration will remain open until the start of each event on February 13th.

Packet Pickup:

Multiple packet pickup options are available and are as followed:

Thursday, February 11, 2021 @ Johnny Z's Powerhouse Racing (18201 Egret Bay Blvd. Suite A, Houston, TX 77058) from 11am to 6pm.

Friday, February 12, 2021 @ Stahlman Park Pavilion (2211 Bluewater Hwy. Surfside Beach, TX 77541) from 5pm to 8pm.

Saturday, February 13, 2021 @ Stahlman Park Pavilion (2211 Bluewater Hwy. Surfside Beach, TX 77541) from 5:30am to 8:10am

Packets will be cautiously pre-stuffed and sorted by shirt size. Volunteers will wear masks and sanitize often. Participants picking up packets will be required to wear masks/face coverings while indoors, outdoors around groups of people and observe social distancing guidelines.

Day of event:

Spectators: Spectators are required to wear masks/face coverings while indoors and outdoors around groups of people. Spectators will be encouraged to observe social distancing guidelines.

Participants: Participants are required to wear masks/face coverings while indoors and in the starting coral while maintaining social distancing. Masks can be removed once the event has started and participants will be encouraged to keep safe passing distances on course.

Each adult event has an allotted 20 minute window from the gun time for participants to start and ensure safe distancing in the coral.

- Marathon Start Window - 7:00am to 7:20am
- Half Marathon Start Window - 7:30am to 7:50am
- 5K - 8:15am to 8:35am

Volunteers & Staff: Volunteers and staff are required to wear face coverings at all times. Volunteers will sanitize regularly. Water stations will be supplied with plenty of bleach wipes, gloves and hand sanitizer. One volunteer will be designated for mixing electrolytes and filling cups. Volunteers will hand out cups holding towards the bottom and participants are to grab towards the top. All food will be individually packaged and handled by only the designated caterers.
