Minutes of the 2021 Annual Reunion July 16-18, 2021 | Asheville, NC

Friday, July 16, 2021

Declan White led the group in the "Pledge of Allegiance" and in the singing of "America." Doug Lively welcomed us to the 81st NALF Reunion and Asheville, NC. Wende Dickey announced a trip to the Billy Graham Retreat and The Cove on Saturday and invited everyone to attend. Minutes from 2019 were read. Minutes were approved and accepted with corrections.

Jennifer Lively recognized the many different Lively Lines that were in attendance and led the group in a game entitled "Never Have I Ever." The Communications Report was given by Jennifer Lively. Motion was made, seconded, and report was accepted.

We are still in the process of removing books from storage and giving them free of charge to libraries and family members without them. Several boxes were brought to the reunion for distribution.

The <u>Scholarship Committee</u> reported that two people have been awarded the scholarship award for this year due to not having a reunion last year.

The President's Report was given by Doug Lively. Old Business: Due to the ease of posting anything on the internet, a discussion arose about maintaining the validity and integrity of genealogy. John Lively led discussion regarding a renewed effort on creating a family website. A motion was made, seconded, and passed regarding allotting \$400 annually for website development.

New Business: A concern arose regarding updating the NALF by-laws and a committee was appointed made up of Tim Lively, Jennifer Lively, and Jane Lively.


