Hyperion 6'4" - Mark Milton Hyperion has superhuman strength, speed, stamina, durability, agility, reflexes, flight, and powerful breath. Mark also has greatly enhanced sensory perceptions which extends to being able to perceive the entire <u>electromagnetic spectrum</u> (IR, UV vision; radio hearing and radar). His "atomic vision" allows him to fire beams of heat from his eyes. Hyperion also possesses the ability to use cosmic energy to augment his life force granting him great longevity and regenerative abilities. Most of the powers are diminished when exposed to "argonite radiation."

Sam Heughan 6'3' As Hyperion from 712. Sam is known for his starring role in tv's Outlander as Jamie Fraser, the action film Red Notice, and comic book movie Bloodshot with Vin Diesel. Alan Ritchson 6'3" As Evil Hyperion. Alan has played Aquaman and Hawk in live action DC roles and is currently the star of Reacher.

Tom Hopper 6'5" As Project Hyperion Tom has had roles in Black Sails, GOT, and currently starring in The Umbrella Academy.





Power Princess 6'8" - Zarda possesses superhuman strength, agility, speed, reflexes, and has the ability to fly. Her aging process is extremely slowed due to being Utopian, a race modified by

The Kree. She is able to drain the life force of others and carries a transparent shield of Utopian design that can block tank shells and be used to redirect energy, and which she can throw so that its edges are able to slice through metal. She, Like Hyperion can survive the vacuum of space and Nuclear explosions. Power Princess has extensive experience in hand-to-hand combat (according to her, she has over five centuries of combat experience and is skilled in discus throwing. She has undergone advanced graduate level studies in both Utopia Isle and Cosmopolis.

Kate Kennedy 6'3" as 712 Zarda. Kate has recently had a large role as a spartan in the Halo game tv show.



Doctor Spectrum - Joseph Ledger Doctor Spectrum derives his abilities from an alien gem called the Power Prism. The Prism gives Joseph the ability to project and manipulate light energy in various colors; create light energy constructs of various shapes, sizes and colors; flight; protection from the rigors of space and the ability to become intangible. The Power Prism is vulnerable to ultra-violet light.

Ethan Peck 6'2" as 712 Doctor Spectrum Ethen Is the grandson of legendary actor Gregory Peck of To Kill A Mockingbird fame, and Currently stars as Spock in Star Trek Strange New Worlds.





Doctor Spectrum - Nenet Nanet has the same Powers as 712 Dr. Emmy Rossum 5'8" As MCU Doctor Spectrum. Emmy has starred in Phantom of the operah and had a leading role in tv's Shameless.





Nighthawk - Kyle Richmond Nighthawk is a superb <u>athlete</u> who, courtesy of an alchemical potion, possesses enhanced strength and increased agility and durability from dusk till dawn. He has also used several costume aids, such as a jet-powered artificial wing system, artificial claw tips, <u>lasers</u> and projectile weapons.

Brandon Sklenar 6'2" as Nighthawk. Brandon Currently stars in the Yellowstone prequel series 1923.







Arcanna - Arcanna Jones 5'8" Arcanna is a sorceress who can innately control natural forces allowing her to fly levitate. Arcanna can greatly realistic illusions, even altering her appearance or others that are hundreds of miles away. Arcanna can also fire bolts of magical energy. Arcanna sometimes used a wooden staff to assist her with flying, much like a witch's flying broomstick. She could also use it as a weapon.

Olivia Taylor Dudley 5'7" as 712 Arcanna Olivia had a starring role in tv's The Magicians. Hannah New 5'6" as Overmind's Moonglow Hannah had a starring role in tv's Black Sails.





Whizzer - James Sanders James possesses super-speed, including heightened speed and reflexes. He is able to run at great speed. While he normally prefers to travel at a few hundred miles per hour, he can increase to supersonic and above if needed. James can also run up walls (approximately 500 feet with a 1000-foot approach) and across water (approximately 1000 feet with a 500-foot approach) He can strike multiple times in a second. He can easily catch bullets out of midair. By fanning his arms and legs rapidly, James can simulate flight by 'air-walking'. Other abilities include -

- Invisibility: Stanley can make his body blur, rendering him invisible to the naked eye.
- Intangibility: By further vibrating, Stanley can phase through objects.
- Aerokinesis: Stanley can create small vortexes and tornadoes by running in circles.
- **Frictionless**: Stanley's body is very resistant to friction.
- **Time Perception**: Stanley's perception of time is heightened.

James can become greatly tired depending on the duration and force used when using his powers and must intake a vast amount of calories and take rests to keep up his strength.

Matt Smith 6'0" as 712 Whizzer Matt has had a leading role in the tv show Dr. Who was The Doctor himself, and has starred in several films. He is currently starring in the GOT prequel House Of The Dragon.



Nuke 5'10" - Albert Gaines Powers

Nuke has the superhuman power to transform nuclear energy for personal use, such as flying by nuclear propulsion and projecting bursts of destructive energy.

Taylor Kitsch 5'11" As Nuke Taylor has played John Carter Of Mars and Gambit, and had a starring role in the tv show Friday Night Lights as well as S2 of True Detective.





Tom Thumb - Thomas Thompson

Tom Thumb is an incredibly scientific genius and brilliant inventor. He can create practically any tool or design that he could think of. Being so short and lacking any real powers beyond his genius, he has an inferiority complex of sorts.

Tyler Labine 6'0" as Tom Thumb Tyler has been in Tucker and Dale vs Evil and recently had a starring role in the Hospital tv drama New Amsterdam.



Golden Archer - Wyatt McDonald 5'5"

McDonald is skilled in hand-to-hand combat and an excellently skilled archer and marksman. Being a taxi driver in the past, he a very skilled driver of vehicles and is great at remembering maps, locations, and directions.

Shia LaBeouf 5'9" As Black archer, formally Golden Archer Shia Has had a leading role in Transformers and a starring role in Indiana Jones And The Kingdom Of The Crystal Skull as well as many other roles.



Lady Lark 5'6" - Linda Lewis Powers

- **Acoustikinesis**: Using her sonic powers, Linda can project her voice to produce sonic blasts, sonic screams, and to cause vertigo in her opponents.^[4]
- Mechanical Wings: She can fly using the Blue Eagle's wings.[4]

Equipment

Skylark uses the wings and anti-grav harness formerly used by the Blue Eagle.

Miley Cyrus 5'5" Miley is a famous singer who had a leading role in tv's Hannah Montana.



Mysterium 6'1" Thomas Lightner

Thomas is a gifted scientist and once had the power of a black hole. He no longer has this power but instead has magical powers that rival that of Doctor Strange as he held a similar role on earth 712.

Nikolaj Coster-Waldau 6'2" Nikolaj is famous for his starring role as Jamie Lannister in the tv show GOT, as well as several other film roles.



Overmind 10'0" Grom

Powers

The Over-Mind is the sum of a billion <u>Eternals</u>. The <u>Watcher</u> considered him a universal threat, enough to break his oath a little. Although the <u>Stranger</u> easily defeated him in their first encounter, the Watcher stated that it was because the Over-Mind was detected before he could amass power. In their next encounter, the Over-Mind had an advantage over a fatigued

Stranger and claimed he could overpower one or two, perhaps even three <u>Watchers</u> simultaneously.[10]

Grom is the "ultimate physical specimen" of his species, The Eternals. He has been known as the champion of champions and said to have conquered a hundred worlds. He eventually set his sights on The Squadron Supreme's universe of 712. Grom has powers of...

- <u>Superhuman Strength</u>: Over-Mind's body is far superior to that of a human being, granting him superhuman strength sufficient to lift at least 10 tons. [4] However, Over-Mind can use his psionic powers to temporarily increase his physical strength by a factor of 7, enough to lift at least 70 tons, [4] up to the class 75. [24]
- Superhuman Speed^[24]
- <u>Superhuman Stamina</u>: [24] He has greater endurance than humans and recover 5 times faster. [4]
- Superhuman Durability: [24] Over-Mind's body is highly resistant to physical injury. He was able to withstand with no effects the combined blows of Hulk and Hyperion. [17]
- Superhuman Agility & Reflexes [24]
- Regeneration: His accelerated metabolism enables him to repair damaged bodily tissues approximately 5 times faster than a human is capable of. [4]
- Immortality: Over-Mind is virtually immortal: [31] He was immune to the effects of aging and diseases. [4]

As the merger of a billion Eternal brains, Over-Mind possessed the following powers:

Psionics

- <u>Telepathy</u>: Over-Mind was able to scan others' mind. [27]
- Mind Control: Over-Mind proved himself to be able to mentally control others with great ease. [2][6][5] This mind control suffers from a few limitations. [24] The people controlled by the Over-Mind rarely realized it, feeling themselves in control. [1]
- <u>Precognition</u>: He also appeared to possess a certain degree of precognitive abilities. [4]
- o <u>Telekinesis</u>: Over-Mind also possessed a limited telekinetic ability in which he can use to levitate objects within 50 feet of him. The weight of these objects must not exceed the weight he can lift physically (without psionic augmentation). [4]
 - Psychokinetics Blasts: He could also project his telekinesis in the form of blasts of concussive force. These blasts are equal to approximately 20 pounds of TNT at a range of 15 feet, and can severely deform a steel plate 1-inch thick or kill a human at a maximum range of 10 feet. [4]
- Psionic Energy Channeling: He could also channel his telekinetic energy to temporarily increase his own physical strength, though he can only do this for a brief period of time, and that incapacitate him to use other abilities at the same time.

It is unknown how long he can maintain this psionic powers before fatigue took over. [4]

<u>Self-Propelled Flight</u>: Over-Mind has proved himself able to fly or levitate on some occasions, and to be unable on others.

Abilities

Over-Mind is an exceptional combatant, having mastered all of the hand to hand combat styles of his race. His extended lifespan, coupled with his psionics, have made him an excellent strategist and tactician. [32]

Weaknesses

- Magic Susceptibility^[24]
- **Mind Control Limitations:** His mind control power suffer from limitations towards superior intellects and powers, and towards any race, [24] or world <u>Eternals</u>. [11] His mind control proved ineffective on <u>Quasar</u> and on Eternals <u>Hyperion</u> and <u>Makkari</u>. [26] This immunity didn't protected from Quasar from mind scanning. [27]
- **Mentally Unstable:** He has suffered of mental breakdowns at two occasions, rendering him vulnerable. [24]

Paraphernalia

Equipment

- An armor and helmet.
- The Tablet of The Eternals, which instructed him on the modus operandi to avenge the Eternals.

Toby Stephens 5'11" Toby has starred as Bond villain in Die Another Day opposite Pierce Brosnan and Had a leading role as Captain Flint In the tv show Black Sails. He recently had a leading role in the remake tv show of Lost In Space.





Scarlett Centurion 6'3" Nathaniel Richards / Jonathan Majors 6'0"

Plot

- 1. The Movie opens with Tom Thumb doing calculations on a massive computer, looking very nervous. Mysterium teleports in and tells him that he is justified in his fear, as the 712 universe in which they live is headed for destruction. The squadron is called together and they formulate a plan to evacuate the planet but soon realize they don't have the time. Mysterium and Tom then instead try to transport the team to another universe. Only a handful make it to the MCU. They are Mysterium, Tom Thumb, Hyperion, Power Princess, Arcanna, Whizzer, The Black Archer, Nuke, Lady Lark. And Nighthawk. They decide to lay low because of the damage they caused in their previous universe, of which was taking over the ear's government and many heroes, villains, and innocents perished. Unbeknownst to them, Overmind also traveled over, who was their greatest foe.
- 2. 2 years later, Nighthawk, who has slowly become wealthy, becomes a congressman. He sees a battle on TV between the Military and Hyperion. The problem is that it's not his Hyperion. He realizes that The Avengers are off the grid, and decides to locate the squadron members to take down the imposter.
- 3. Unable to locate his Hyperion, he locates other squadron members P. Princess, Arcanna, Doctor Spectrum, Whizzer, and Nuke. They find the variant and battle, only to be defeated, with the whizzer having his legs broken, and nuke being killed.
- 4. Nighthawk leads Zarda to a secret military facility, where he tells her Hyperion is kept. She is puzzled and angry as he had told her previously that he could not locate him. However he shows that it is another variant, and the two retrieve him and convince him to help. This Hyperion was captured by A.I.M. during the events of The Multiverse Of Madness. and has been kept as a secret weapon, yet to be used. It is assumed that is how evil Hyperion entered the MCU as well, through a multiversal rift. Only he was not

- captured. This puzzles Nighthawk as to why he has made his presence known now. He wonders if this has anything to do with recent disappearances of government figures and others acting strangely and out of character.
- 5. A second battle ensues when Variant 1 Hyperion shows up with a variant of Arcanna and Doctor Spectrum, as well as Tom Thumb, and The Black Archer. Nighthawk quickly realizes that their foes are under mind control and deduces that it is Overmind. He slips away from the battle and finds Overmind and attempts to defeat him, thus shutting down the mind control. During the course of the battle, Zarda, Doctor Spectrum, and Arcanna are being beat down and Evil Hyperion is close to landing the final kill blow on variant Hyperion. Help soon arrives in the form of Original Hyperion and the tide soon turns. Nighthawk is able to defeat Overmind, and the ones he controlled stp fighting, except for one, Evil Hyperion. He laughs at the thought that a moron like Overmind could control him. He was a means to an end for him to conquer the planet and kill all that opposed him. In a final battle, he is defeated and crippled by the other two Hyperions.
- 6. Nighthawk notes to the Squadron, now back together fully that the government seems to have returned to normal. As Overmind is locked away, he tells Nighthawk that their win was only temporary, as his master is coming, The Scarlett Centurion, a variant of Kang. Wondering what to do with Variant Hyperion, Mysterium appears and tells them that he has learned a few tricks while in this universe and can help send him back to his home universe, though there are some out there that will not be happy with the act. Original Doctor Spectrum and Arcanna decide to go with him, as his earth did not have a Squadron Supreme. The rest of the team decide to stay and prepare for what is to come and whoever this Scarlet Centurion is.
