The Inner City Youth Orchestra of Los Angeles (ICYOLA) is a California 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation that transforms the lives and minds of young people in Inner City Los Angeles through high-quality music education. It teaches inner city youth the great music of the world, and provides opportunities for them to perform that music in the most magnificent settings of our community. It prepares its members for advanced study and high-caliber success in music, and instills the ancillary benefits that music instruction provides: problem-solving skills, critical thinking, self-reliance, self-confidence, self-discipline, and the crystallization and pursuit of meaningful purpose. ICYOLA offers four programs: the ICYOLA Orchestra Program, the Los Angeles Orchestra Fellowship (that it operates in collaboration with the Los Angeles Chamber Orchestra and the Thornton School of Music at the University of Southern California), the South Side Chicago Youth Orchestra (a new sister orchestra to ICYOLA); and the Youth Orchestra of Tsakane, South Africa.



SCIENCE | BRIDGE BUILDERS FOUNDATION

Founded in 1999, the **Bridge Builders Foundation**'s mission is to remove the barriers of race, poverty, ignorance, and despair through Mentoring, STEM/STEAM Programs, Academic Support, and Healthcare Awareness. Since 2002, the BBF has provided targeted, innovative science programs that seek to expose, encourage, and support minority youths' pursuit of education and careers in STEM/STEAM disciplines.
