Are you an employer?

You are responsible for making sure employees receive immediate attention if they are ill or injured at work. Accidents and illnesses can happen at any time and first aid can saves lives and prevent minor injuries from becoming major injuries.

What employers need to do

You must make appropriate first aid arrangements for your workplace. In doing so you should consider the circumstances of your workplace, workforce and the health and safety risks that may be present to help you decide what arrangements you need to put in place.

Some small low risk workplaces need to only have a first aid box and an appointed person to take charge of first aid arrangements such as calling 999 and stocking the first aid kits. The appointed person does not necessarily need training. However, if your workplace has more significant risks for example you use machinery or hazardous materials you are more likely to need a trained first aider. You must provide your employees with details of the first aid arrangements.

What training do I need?

Where your first aid needs assessment indicates that trained firstaiders are required, the level of training undertaken should be indicated in the assessment. Typically, this will either be First Aid at Work or Emergency First Aid at work. You should select the most suitable option. To comply with your legal duties under the Health and safety (first aid) regulations 1981 that choice must be appropriate and adequate. You should consider how many people you will have trained. For example what if the first aider is off sick?

How do I select a training provider?

When you are choosing a training provider you should check..

- The qualifications expected of the trainers and assessors.
- Monitoring and Quality assurance systems are in place.

How long does the qualification last for?

Once trained, the qualification will be valid for three years but it is recommended that you have annual refresher training.
