### 2019 Information for Politicians & Political Groups

We are pleased to extend an invitation to local politicians and political groups to march in our Annual Fourth of July Parade which will be held on Thursday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019. The Town of Merrimack's Annual 4th of July Parade is organized by the Parks & Recreation Department and is one of the larger Independence Day Parades in the State of New Hampshire.

The Parade will promptly begin at 1:00 pm from the Commons Shopping Plaza (515 Daniel Webster Highway). The Parade travel south down Daniel Webster Highway, takes a right onto Baboosic Lake Road to travel past Mastricola Elementary School and then takes a left onto O'Gara Drive. The Parade concludes at Merrimack High School. The entire route is 1.5 miles long. All participants must be registered in advance and checked no later than 12:30 pm on the day of the Parade.

**\*Please note that there are no shuttle buses to bring you from where the Parade ends back to where it begins.\***

If you are currently an elected official representing New Hampshire, we welcome you to join us near the front of the Parade. If you would prefer to march with your supporters with campaign signs, floats, etc., then we would ask you to join them near the back of the Parade.

If you are running for a political office, you will be placed near the back of the Parade with the other political candidates and groups. Since New Hampshire has a Republican Governor, Republican Candidates will appear in the Parade lineup before Democratic Candidates. Candidates will be placed in alphabetical order within their party. Other political organizations will be placed at the end of the Parade behind the Candidates.

### Parade Rules & Regulations

- **The Fourth of July Parade will be held on Thursday, July 4, 2018 and will begin at 1:00 pm**
- All parade entries are subject to approval by the Town. Entries will be notified prior to the parade.
- All parade participants must be responsible for their own safety.
- Floats must be safely assembled and proceed along the parade route with the highest standard of safety.
- Vehicle drivers are solely responsible for their own safety and that of their vehicle. Drivers must remain with the vehicle at all times.
- Vehicle drivers, trailers and vehicles must be properly licensed and inspected.
- Participants must obey police and parade officials at all times.
- Refusal to comply will result in immediate withdrawal from the parade.
- Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed by parade participants.
- Do not throw candy from vehicles or floats. Please have designated walkers to hand out candy so that kids are not running into the street to pick it up.
- Parade officials have complete authority over the parade.
