This use-at-your-own-risk facility typically opens in April and remains open through October, as weather permits. Bicycles, roller skates, roller blades, skateboards, scooters and other non-motorized vehicles are allowed at the O'Gara Drive Skate Park. For safety reasons, the skate park will be closed if it is raining. There is **no** attendant on duty and the Town of Merrimack is not responsible for lost or stolen items or any injury or accident incurred during the use of the Skate Park. (NH RSA 507-B:11)

Safe Sitter<sup>®</sup> prepares students in grades 6-8 to be safe when they're home alone, watching younger siblings, or babysitting. The lessons are filled with fun activities and role-playing exercises. Students learn how to prevent unsafe situations and what to do when faced with dangers such as power failures or weather emergencies. Participants will learn tips to manage behavior along with the ages and stages of child development. Class will also include rescue skills such as choking rescue and CPR and how to assess and respond to injuries and illnesses. Lastly this course will teach participants how to screen jobs, discuss fees, and greet employers to set students up for success now and in the future. Students practice these skills through various role plays. Course is taught by Michelle Panaccione who is a Registered Nurse in the Cardiac ICU at Boston Children's Hospital and an Instructor for the American Heart Association and Safe Sitter.

If a family member or co-worker suddenly started choking or collapsed in front of you; would you know what to do? Would you know how to react if someone suddenly stopped breathing? The purpose of this course is to train you to recognize and respond to emergency medical situations and provide basic care in respiratory & cardiac emergencies including how to use an AED to help save a life. Participants who successfully complete this course will receive a certification American in Adult CPR/AED with Pediatric CPR from the American Red Cross valid for 2 years.

Accidents happen. People get hurt, sick, or lost outdoors. The temperature drops, the wind picks up, and it starts to rain. Would you know what to do? Many backcountry emergencies are preventable and even when bad things happen, sometimes the wrong care can make things worse. By learning a few skills, you can make the difference between a good outcome and a bad one and maybe even save a life.

Wilderness First Aid is the perfect course for the outdoor enthusiast or trip leader who wants a basic level of wilderness first aid training for short trips with family, friends, and outdoor groups. The 16 hour long (twoday) program focuses on the skills of: Response and Assessment, Musculoskeletal Injuries, Environmental Emergencies, Survival Skills, Soft Tissue Injuries, and Medical Emergencies.

Participants who complete the course and pass the written and practical skills will receive a Wilderness First Aid certification from SOLO which is valid for 2 years. SOLO is among the leaders in Wilderness Medicine Training and certification. Coffee and snacks will be provided each day.

Participant MUST have a current CPR certification upon completion of course. If you do not already hold this certification an optional Adult CPR Recertification Course will be offered on Saturday evening for an additional fee of \$50.00
