## **Town of Merrimack**2023 Fourth of July Parade Participant Guidelines



- The Fourth of July Parade will be held on Tuesday, July 4th, 2023and will begin at 1:00 pm
- Please do not hand out candy or other materials to parade participants this year. There is also no spraying the crowd with water as each year we receive numerous complaints about it.
- All parade entries are subject to approval by the Town. Entries will be notified prior to the parade if there is an issue with their application. Walk in Groups will not be accepted. Registrations must be received by Friday, June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- Floats must be safely assembled and proceed along the parade route with the highest standard of safety.
- Vehicle drivers are solely responsible for their own safety and that of their vehicle and must remain with the vehicle at all times.
- Vehicle drivers, trailers and vehicles must be properly licensed and inspected.
- Participants must obey police and parade officials at all times.
- Any participants riding on an ATV or bicycle must wear a helmet.
- Refusal to comply will result in immediate withdrawal from the parade.
- Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed by parade float participants.
- This is a family friendly parade. As such, we expect that all floats will have appropriate displays.
- Parade officials have complete authority over the parade.
