## **Information for Politicians & Political Groups**

We are pleased to extend an invitation to local politicians and political groups to march in our Annual Fourth of July Parade which will be held on Tuesday, July 4th. The Town of Merrimack's Annual 4th of July Parade is organized by the Parks & Recreation Department and is one of the larger Independence Day Parades in the State of New Hampshire.

The Annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade will begin promptly begin at 1:00 pm from the Commons Shopping Plaza located at 515 Daniel Webster Highway, Merrimack. The Parade travel south down Daniel Webster Highway, takes a right onto Baboosic Lake Road to travel past Mastricola Elementary School and then takes a left onto O'Gara Drive. The Parade concludes at Merrimack High School. The entire route is 1.5 miles long. All participants must be registered in advance and checked no later than 12:30 pm on the day of the Parade.

\*Please note that there are no shuttle buses to bring you from where the Parade ends back to where it begins. Many participants will pre-stage some vehicles at the end of the parade in advance and then shuttle members of the group to the Parade starting area\*

If you are currently an elected official representing New Hampshire, we welcome you to join us near the front of the Parade. If you would prefer to march with your supporters with campaign signs, floats, etc., then we would ask you to join them near the back of the Parade.

If you are running for a political office, you will be placed near the back of the Parade with the other political candidates and groups. Since New Hampshire currently has a Republican Governor, Republican Candidates will appear in the Parade lineup before Democratic Candidates. Candidates will be placed in alphabetical order within their political party. Other political organizations will be placed at the end of the Parade behind the Candidates.

### **Parade Rules & Regulations**

The Fourth of July Parade will be held on Tuesday, July 4th, 2023 and will begin at 1:00 pm

- All parade entries are subject to approval by the Town and must be registered no later than Thursday, June 30th. Entries will be notified of acceptance prior to the parade.
- Floats must be safely assembled and proceed along the parade route with the highest standard of safety.
  - Vehicle drivers are solely responsible for their own safety and that of their vehicle and must remain with the vehicle at all times.
  - Vehicle drivers, trailers and vehicles must be properly licensed and inspected.
  - Participants must obey police and parade officials at all times.
  - Any participants riding on an ATV or bicycle must wear a helmet.
  - Refusal to comply will result in immediate withdrawal from the parade.
  - Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed by parade float participants.
  - This is a family friendly parade. As such, we expect that all floats will have appropriate displays. Parade officials have complete authority over the parade.
