REAL LIFE CHURCH STORY AND HISTORY

Real Life Church has a short, but eventful history. In the fall of 2023, after much prayer and counsel from leaders in the Genesis Conference of the Free Methodist Church, a small group of dedicated and generous followers of Jesus Christ started worshiping in a pole barn with the purpose of planting a new church in our community. In less than a year, they had outgrown the pole barn and were able to lease a small section of an old Agway building. God continued the good work, and in September of 2024, Real Life Church was officially launched.

By the spring of 2025, the church had grown to the point that two services were needed. After praying for His leading, God graciously provided an opportunity for Real Life Church to purchase a larger building just down the street from the Agway site. A mortgage was secured and a closing date has been tentatively set for early November. 2025.

In September of 2025, God again moved in wondrous ways as the church celebrated its newly achieved status as a full-fledged Society in the Genesis Conference of the Free Methodist Church. God has been at work in RLC; and confidence and hope are high that He is going to continue to work in and through Real Life Church to build His Kingdom.

FUTURE PLANS



Real Life Church will be moving from our present location to our own building on Edward St., Arcade. The new building will need remodeling to transform it to a place of worship and ministry. The plan is for work to begin shortly after the beginning of the year 2026, and be completed and ready for movein by the fall of 2026. The new facility will give us double the sanctuary seating capacity, triple the lobby space, and larger classrooms than our current facility. In addition to work on the building itself, we will also need to enlarge the parking lot at the new location.

Through our capital campaign we will spend the next two years raising additional funds to remodel the new facility and to reduce the mortgage debt. The total campaign goal is \$350,000. It is estimated that the cost of remodeling and improvements will be \$200,000. The balance of funds raised through the capital campaign will be used to reduce the mortgage debt of \$258,750 to free up funds for other ministries and growth.


