

## Design Challenge - Patch - 2026

Team Mission Patches for this year should represent the school, the team, and the student astronaut challenge competition. Do not include any copyrighted symbols or images. For examples of actual NASA mission patches, visit:

<https://www.nasa.gov/johnson/HWHAP/mission-patches>. Your final patch should not be AI generated, but you can utilize tools to help you brainstorm.

Mission patches should be submitted, via email, to [danielle.miller03@gmail.com](mailto:danielle.miller03@gmail.com) as a single page PDF that includes the patch and the narrative paragraph. The deadline for this challenge is 11:59pm, eastern time, TUESDAY JANUARY 20, 2026. Late patch designs will be accepted, but points will be deducted from the overall bonus point score if patches are submitted after the deadline.

Here are the official specifications for designing NASA Mission Patches:

1. The patch size is limited to 16 square inches of surface area (e.g. 4" square).
2. No more than 8 solid Pantone Matching System (PMS) block colors.
3. No gradient colors or photography (e.g., bitmaps, .tiff, .tif, .jpeg, etc.).
4. Letters and names must be at least one quarter inch tall in a four inch patch.
5. There must be a one-sixteenth inch wide border around the outside of the patch.
6. No lines should be thinner than 1 point line weight at patch actual size, for stitching purposes. (A 1-point line is about 1 thread width.)

Your patch design should be featured and explained to the judges in your design challenge presentation. Points earned will be added to the overall design challenge score.
