Good morning Kris,

I received your email regarding the upcoming roadway widening/improvements on Farm Roads 146 & 129 that are scheduled to be performed later this year and wanted to share some additional information to help address your questions.

As Rick mentioned in his correspondence, we are currently working in coordination with the City of Springfield to acquire some remaining easements for a sanitary sewer main extension that will be completed as part of our roadway widening project. I anticipate that we'll be able to finalize this remaining easement work by the end of June, which would allow us to advertise the project for bidding in early July. That would put us on track to begin construction work by mid to late August of this year. The proposed roadway improvements will require approximately 7 months for final completion.

With regard to the scope of work that we'll be performing with this project, the following list of roadway improvements will be completed:

- Farm Road 129 will be widened to a 3-lane section (2 driving lanes + 1 center turn lane) with new curb & gutter starting at Farm Road 146 and continuing south to Sunshine
- Farm Road 146 will be widened to a 3-lane section (2 driving lanes + 1 center turn lane) with new curb & gutter starting at West Bypass and continuing west to FR 129
- New pedestrian sidewalks will be constructed along both sides of Farm Roads 146 & 129 throughout the newly widened segments
- Stormwater improvements will be completed along both sides of Farm Roads 146 & 129 in order to eliminate the existing open-ditches, and to move the stormwater underground into concrete drainage pipes
- A new Roundabout will be constructed at the intersection of FR 146 & FR 129 to improve traffic flow and provide increased safety for motorists and pedestrians at this existing intersection
