

Swimming Pool and Hot Tub use and safety

Our large, 9 x 4m heated pool, is 1.2m at the shallow end and 1.8m at the deep end.

Showering before use

We request that all guest shower before entering the Pool, to remove any loose Sunscreen or other body cosmetic products. These can cause real problems to the filtration system in the Pool.

There is a Solar-powered shower next to the Hot Tub. We request that all guests use the shower prior to entering the Hot Tub. With it being Solar-powered, please note it will only generate hot water during sunlight hours.

Notes on Sunscreen

We understand that it is vitally important to have adequate sun protection during the day, so if entering the pool during the day, please apply water-resistant Sunscreen at least 15 minutes prior to showering and entering the pool. The sunscreen will have absorbed into the skin by this time. Please re-apply sunscreen regularly during the day.

Pool cover

The Pool cover is motorised. To use it, turn the key on the far side of the pool cover bar and the cover will retract. To recover the pool, repeat this action by turning the key the other way. It will take 2 people to successfully cover and uncover the pool.

We request that the Pool is covered after use. This is vital to maintain the temperature of the water, and helps to avoid petals and debris from getting into the water.

Pool safety notices and rules

- Please shower before entering the Pool.
- No diving.
- Children must be supervised at all times.
- No food or drink.
- Any persons using the Swimming Pool do so at their own risk.
- Please take great care to avoid spending too much time in the water during the peak Sunshine hours of 11am – 3pm. Take breaks and re-apply sunscreen regularly to avoid sun damage to the skin.
