Rabbit Foot Fern (*Davallia Tyermanii*)

Description

Bring good luck to your business by adding a lush and delicate looking Fern!

Rabbit Foot Fern has spectacular lacy light to dark green foliage and yellowish hairy rhizome that cascades over the pots and resemble spiderlike appearance when growing quite long. This feature makes them ideal for hanging baskets. Rabbit Foot Fern also creates an elegant display in decorative and mixed containers. Small plugs of this amazing Fern are so happy in terrarium or vivarium and make a unique appearance with a combination of other varieties.

Care

Uses: Tropical garden, hanging basket, terrarium, vivarium

Light: Part to full shade

Humidity: loves humidity

Water: Needs a well-draining potting soil

Common Issue: Direct sunlight will scorch the leaves and turn the rhizomes brown, Mealybug and scale

Toxicity: Non-Toxic

Nephrolepis cordifolia Duffi Fern

Description

A green rounded shape leaves Fern with compact growth. Its lemon fragrance and arching fronds make it an attractive feature in your garden. Lemon Button Fern is also one of the most popular ferns used in the terrarium because it loves a moist and humid environment. The foliage will be scorched if it is placed in front of the air conditioning or heater. They grow well in a semi-shaded spot with filtered light.

Care

Uses Indoor plant, green wall, hanging basket, terrarium, self-watering planters

Light: Semi-shade

Humidity: Warm and humid environment

Water: keep them moist

Common Issue: Direct sunlight will scorch the leaves, Mealybugs

Toxicity: Non-Toxic

Microsrum Crocodyllus

Description

A very attractive terrestrial plant whose mosaic pattern and glossy leaves resemble crocodile skin. The leaves are leathery and wrinkle looking in appearance. One interesting fact about Crocodile Fern is its ability to grow in rocks cracks or attach to moss-covered trees. This feature makes it an ideal choice for the vivarium. The young plants also add stunning texture to your terrarium.

It grows well in a shady and humid environment, however, it needs extremely well drained soils.

Care

Uses : Tropical garden, terrarium, vivarium, self watering planters

Light: Shade spot

Humidity: loves humidity

Water: Needs very well-drained soil

Common Issue: Vey wet soil may cause root rot, Mealybug

Toxicity: Non-Toxic




Pteris ensiformis 'Evergemiensis' (Silver Lace Fern)

Description

Looking for a distinctive variety of fern adding a noticeable feature in your miniature garden?

What makes Silver Lace distinctive from other types of ferns is its beautiful variegated green and silver fronds with longish stems. A warm and humid environment like a terrarium, bottle garden or vivarium provides an ideal growing condition for this plant. Fern Silver Lace is an ornamental plant that brings a striking look in mixed plantings or decorative containers on your balcony.



Care

Uses: Mixed plantings, hanging baskets, terrarium, vivarium

Light: Shade with bright light

Humidity: Adores humidity

Water: Needs a well-drained substrate

Common Issue: Stay away from dry condition

Toxicity: Non-Toxic

Asplenium nidus Crispy Wave *Bird's Nest Fern*

Description

Dreaming of a tropical paradise in your home or office?

Splenium Crispy Wave with its sculptural feature has become a popular terrarium and indoor plant among plant lovers.

Its stunning light green wavy fronds with the thick textural leaves give it the name "Crispy Wave". Like other ferns, Crispy Wave thrives in humid environments and can not tolerate frost or dry conditions. They can be used in mixed indoor arrangements or in decorative pots and add luscious style to your room.

Care

Uses: Decorative planter, self watering planters, terrarium

Light: Moderate and indirect light

Humidity: High humidity

Water: Do not direct water into the crown which can cause the crown rot

Common Issue: Too much bright light will cause the fronds to lighten.

Toxicity: Non-Toxic





Phlebodium aureum

Blue Star Fern

Description

Add a touch of contrast to your collection with bluish-grey foliage of Fern blue star. Its attractive array of frond shape and colour makes it a real standout in your houseplant collection. Another special feature of this variety is its golden brown creeping rhizomes giving that the name of Bear's Paw Fern. The young plant has uneven fronds which turn to more uniform and regular shape when the plant matures. It grows up to 60-90 cm in height making them perfect for containers. As a rainforest plant is an excellent choice for terrariums.



Care

Uses: Indoor plant, container, hanging basket, terrarium

Light: Bright indirect light

Humidity: Average to high humidity

Water: Keep the soil moist but not wet. Check the topsoil before watering.

Common Issue: Overwatering may cause fungus disease

Toxicity: Non-Toxic
