

To Whom It May Concern:

The following is a list of the insurance requirements for contractors/subcontractors doing business with AMLI. Before a contract can be awarded, the supplier must provide a certificate of liability insurance evidencing coverage of the minimum limits detailed below.

<u>REQUIRED</u> ***The following Additional Insured and Non-Contributory language must be stated in either the Description section OR as an endorsement or second page:

"The Owners and AMLI Management Company and their respective subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, owners, partners, members, managers, trustees, officers, directors and employees are listed as Additional Insureds. Coverage should be primary and non-contributing and allow Waiver of Subrogation by Insured."

Also, please include in the Description section a brief description of the Services provided (i.e. carpet replacement, interior painting, unit cleaning, carpet cleaning, resurfacing, etc).
