Contest Period

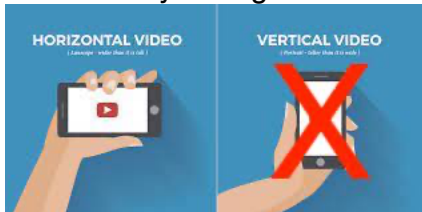
All submissions must be received by March 29, 2024 at 11:59 pm.

Contest Guidelines

1. There is no fee to enter the competition.
2. The competition is open to Elementary and Middle School students.
3. Fill out the entry form that will include Name of the Student, School, Date of Birth, Grade, Declaration of Original Film, Parent/Guardian Consent, Parent/Guardian Contact Info and Parent/Guardian Signature. Proof of age, identity or eligibility may be required.
4. All entries must be the students' original work.
5. The use of AI-generators is not permitted.

How to Film

1. You can film with a smartphone (Iphone, Android), Ipad, laptop and or a handheld camera device.
2. The film should be recorded **horizontally** and in the **highest resolution** available in your digital device. They are meant to be seen on the big screen.



3. Choose from one of these **categories**:
 - “Shooting Star” – films of 15 to 30 seconds
 - “Fireball” - films of 1 to 3 minutes
4. Examples of **genres**:
 - How-To
 - Documentary
 - Comedy
 - Music Video
 - Game Show
 - Buddy Movie
 - Action Movie
 - Superhero Movie
 - Drama

 - Create your own!
5. The films will be judged on their content, concept, and value:
- Shows the beauty of our planet and how to preserve it through climate solutions.
 - Alters perceptions or ways of thinking towards Climate Change.
 - Promotes Climate Action.
 - Makes innovative use of the media.
 - Step outside the box. There is much more to Climate Action than recycling. Other topics are nature conservancy, waste reduction, energy, air pollution, food security.

Things You Should Know

1. If you are submitting more than one project, you need to fill out an Entry Form per film.
2. If you're working in a group, the director of the film is to fill out the Entry Form.
3. If you are using music, there is royalty free music available online or you can consider doing original music.
4. Make sure wardrobe for on-screen actors is appropriate for children between the ages of 5 and 15.
5. Watch for words that might be offensive to others.
