~ God's Plan for Your Life ~

As we prepare to go into the New Year 2019, know this... GOD STILL HAS A WONDERFUL PLAN FOR YOU, DESPITE YOUR PAST OR PRESENT SITUATION!

In Jeremiah 29:10-11, we see that despite the rebellion of the children of Judah towards God in turning away to worship false gods and rejecting His warnings through His true prophets; God's original plan to bring them into the promised land remained. When Judah's seventy years of Babylonian exile ended, as promised, God brought them back to their homeland. "Put in gardens and eat what grows in that country."

"Marry and have children. Encourage your children to marry and have children so that you'll thrive in that country and not waste away."

"Make yourselves at home there (for a while) and work for the country's welfare."

"Pray for Babylon's well-being. If things go well for Babylon, things will go well for you."
