Day 1-3: Preparation and Consecration - Pressing into the New

Declaration of Faith for 2025: I Still Believe!

Prophetic Strategy & Instructions: Reclaim Our Wells in 2025!

Scripture References:

- **Genesis 26:18**, "Isaac reopened the wells that had been dug in the time of his father Abraham, which the Philistines had stopped up after Abraham died, and he gave them the same names his father had given them."
- According to Galatians 3:29, we have a right to reclaim our spiritual and natural/practical
 wells: "If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the
 promise."

Day 1-3: Preparation and Consecration - Pressing into the New

Scripture Reference: Joel 2:12-13, "Turn to me now, while there is time. Give me your hearts. Come with fasting, weeping, and mourning."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Ask God to prepare your heart for the fast.
- 2. Pray for humility and a willingness to seek God.
- 3. Ask God to consecrate you for the next 21 days.

Daily Devotion: Reflect on your relationship with God. Ask yourself if there are any areas where you need to seek forgiveness or reconciliation.

Scripture Reference: Hebrews 6:1,"Therefore let us leave the elementary teachings about Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again the foundation of repentance from acts that lead to death, and of faith in God."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Ask God to grace you with His power and strength to press into everything new that he has for you in 2025.
- 2. Pray for new faith, hope, vision, insight, wisdom, understanding, strength, passion, zeal, you name it!

Reclaiming Our Spiritual Wells: Forgiveness of Sin

Scripture Reference: Ephesians 1:7 "In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace."

Reflection: Remind yourself there is no sin big enough that God's love doesn't reach nor cover and that the blood of Jesus absolved all guilt, shame, and condemnation.

Day 4-6: Seeking God's Manifestation

Daily Devotion: Reflect on times when you've experienced God's presence. Ask yourself how you can seek God's manifestation in your daily life.

Scripture Reference: Psalm 27:4, "One thing I ask from the Lord, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and to seek him in his temple."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Ask God to manifest Himself in your life.
- 2. Pray for a deeper understanding of God's presence.
- 3. Ask God to reveal Himself to you in new ways.

Reclaiming Our Spiritual Wells: Eternal Life

Scripture Reference: John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son.

Reflection: Our responsibility is to acknowledge and confess our sins so we can prosper in our spirit and relationship with God.Do your UTMOST best to OBEY God to the end and receive eternal life with God.

Day 7-9: Demonstrations of God's Power

Daily Devotion: Reflect on times when you've seen God's power demonstrated. Ask yourself how you can trust God for greater demonstrations of His power.

Scripture Reference: 1 Corinthians 2:4-5, "My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, so that your faith might not rest on human wisdom, but on God's power."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Ask God to demonstrate His power in your life.
- 2. Pray for a greater understanding of God's authority.
- 3. Ask God to show Himself strong on your behalf.

Reclaiming Our Spiritual Wells: Holy Spirit

Scripture Reference: John 14:16-17 "16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— 17 the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be[a] in you."

Reflection: Unclog the well of friendship with the Holy Spirit and ask God to show you/remind you of the many benefits of a relationship with the Holy Spirit.

Day 10-12: Full Fruition

Daily Devotion: Reflect on areas where you're waiting for a harvest. Ask yourself if there's anything you need to adjust or change to see full fruition.

Scripture Reference: Galatians 6:9, "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Ask God to bring your endeavors to full fruition.
- 2. Pray for perseverance and endurance.
- 3. Ask God to give you a harvest of righteousness.

Daily Devotion: Reflect on God's concept of due season, at the appropriate time, God's perfect timing, that which He has promised will manifest. Create a list of your 2025 due seasons with scripture promises.

Scripture Reference: Galatians 6:9 "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Pray for God to help you prepare for every opportunity so to put yourself in position to receive your due season.
- 2. Pray for God's wisdom, understanding, and discernment to remain in His will as you await the manifestation of your due season.

Reclaiming Our Spiritual Wells: Identity as Children of God and in Christendom

Scripture Reference: John 1:8-12 "He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light. The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world. He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God."

Reflection: We can boldly declare: I am a son/daughter of God! We have Christ's DNA and ability within us.

Day 13-15: Faith and Trust

Daily Devotion: Reflect on times when you've had to trust God. Ask yourself if there are any areas where you need to increase your faith.

Scripture Reference: Hebrews 11:6, "And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Ask God to increase your faith and trust.
- 2. Pray for a deeper understanding of God's faithfulness.
- 3. Ask God to help you trust Him for the impossible.

Daily Devotion: Just as Jesus' resurrection was followed by earthquakes and other significant events, we can expect shifts and changes after receiving God's promises. Let's press into God and trust Him to stabilize our feet in uncertain times.

Scripture Reference: Psalm 18:33, "He maketh my feet like hinds' feet, and setteth me upon my high places."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Stability in Shifting Times: Ask God to equip you with stability and trust in Him, even when circumstances seem uncertain or conflicting.
- 2. Trusting God's Plan: Pray for faith to trust God's plan and timing, even if the outcome is not exactly as you envisioned.
- 3. Keeping Eyes on the Prize: Ask God to help you stay focused on the promise and not get distracted by shifting circumstances.
- 4. Continuing to Trust After the Promise: Pray for continued trust and faith in God after receiving the promise, knowing that new challenges and shifts may arise.

Reclaiming Our Natural/Practical Wells: Community

Scripture Reference: Romans 12:5 "so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others."

Reflection: Sense of community creates belonging and a connection with purpose. We belong to the BEST community ever in the Kingdom of God. Are you connected to your God ordained community?

Day 16-18: Obedience and Surrender

Daily Devotion: Reflect on areas where you need to obey God. Ask yourself if there's anything you need to surrender to God.

Scripture Reference: John 14:15, "If you love me, keep my commands."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Ask God to help you obey His commands.
- 2. Pray for a willingness to surrender to God's will.
- 3. Ask God to give you a heart of obedience.

Daily Devotion: Reflect on being laser focused - refusing to take your eyes off of God and His promises. If you lose focus, you miss what God has for you.

Scripture Reference: Proverbs 4:25, "Says to let your eyes look directly forward, and your gaze be straight before you."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Pray to remain laser focused.
- 2. Pray to stand on God's promises no matter what.
- 3. Pray to stay in waiting with great anticipation and faith.

Reclaiming Our Practical/Natural Wells: Provision

Scripture Reference: Philippians 4:19 "And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus."

Reflection: Believe and declare: I have a right to God's provisions.

Day 19-21: Celebration and Thanksgiving*

Daily Devotion: Reflect on the blessings in your life. Ask yourself how you can show gratitude to God for His goodness.

Scripture Reference: Psalm 100:4-5, "Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations."

Prayer Points:

- 1. Thank God for the blessings in your life.
- 2. Pray for a heart of gratitude.
- 3. Ask God to help you celebrate His goodness.

Reclaiming Our Natural/Practical Wells: Purpose & Direction

Scripture Reference: Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

Reflection: Coming into purpose is not always easy. Ask God to help you overcome challenges, hindrances, distractions, delays keeping you from your purpose.
