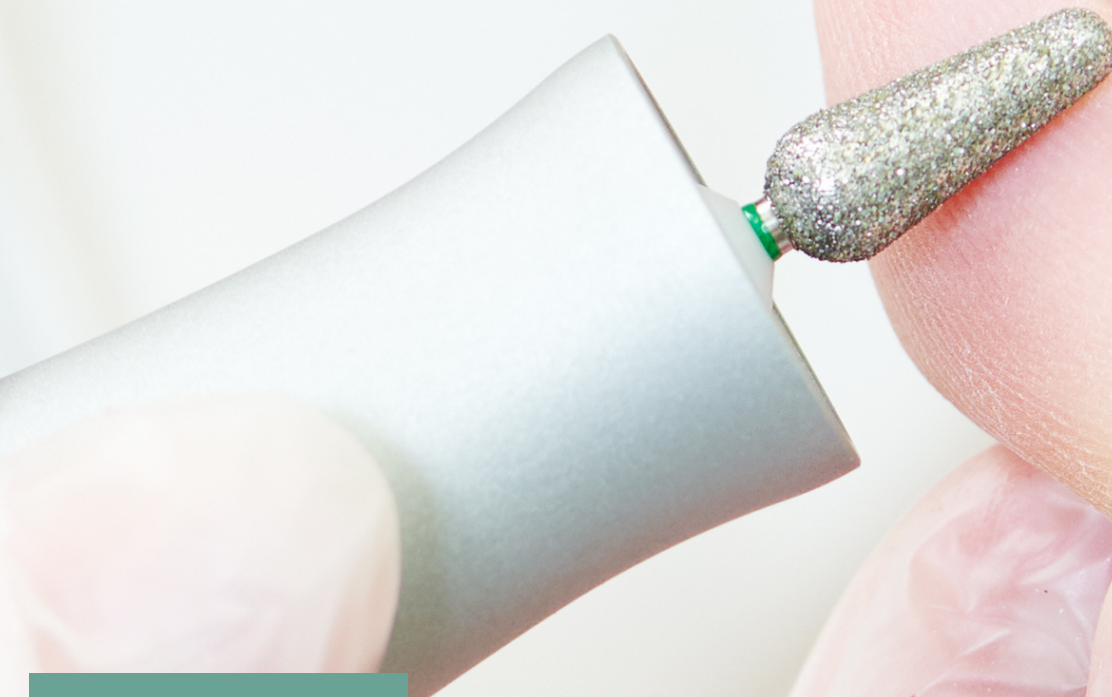

About Us

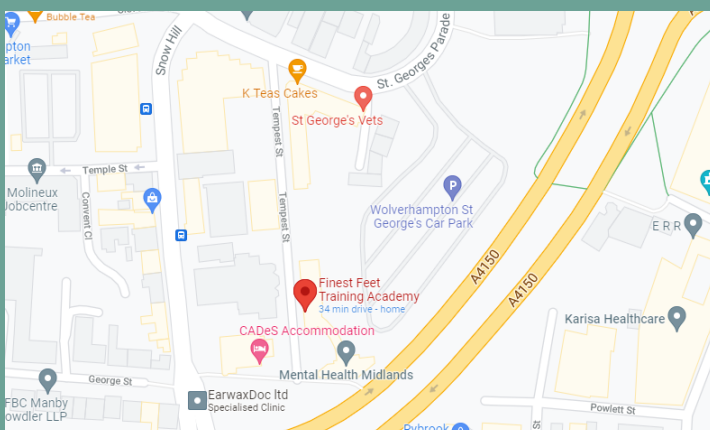

Our spacious training centre offers a welcoming and friendly learning environment for all learners to train and qualify.

The training centre is a convenient 10 minute walk from the railway and bus station. We do have a NCP car park next to the building, where a small fee can be paid for the allocated times.

Due to the location, there are plenty of accommodation options for our learners.



The Qualification

The Level 3 Accredited Foot Health Practitioner course is a recognised qualification, promoting the development of the skills and knowledge needed to become a Foot Health Practitioner (FHP). This qualification also promotes the prevention of common foot conditions and the treatment of them.

This course is suitable for learners over 18 who are looking to or already work within the Health & Social Care sector.

Most of our teaching is student-lead, working online at a pace that suits you and allows you to thrive. 80% of your theory units will need to be completed before practical training can be booked. All theory units must be completed before attending practical training.

All learners will then complete 2 weeks of practical training at our COVID safe training facility in Wolverhampton, West Midlands. During this training, learners will collect evidence for a portfolio and work with real clients to build their skill set.

Ongoing support is offered throughout both the theory and practical by our tutors, and we will thoroughly provide the help needed to ensure our learners feel comfortable and confident.

The price of this course is £1800 (+ VAT). If you choose our pay monthly scheme, the course is £2000 (+ VAT).

Our online learning modules are split into nine units, all including an assignment to be completed. We aim to cater to all our learners' needs, so we offer full and continued support whilst completing the theory modules of this course.

All theory units must be completed and passed before attending any practical training.

Practical Training

Our learners will be required to attend two weeks of practical training based in Wolverhampton in order to graduate. This includes a range of lectures, activities and working on real-life patients to prepare you for your own practice. On average, a learner will see between 15-30 patients before graduating. All practical activities are supervised by your tutor and regular feedback is provided. On the last day of practical, an exam will be given to each learner to test knowledge retention.

To enrol onto this course, learners must be 18 years of age or over. An interest within the foot care field helps, however we welcome learners of any previous professional background.

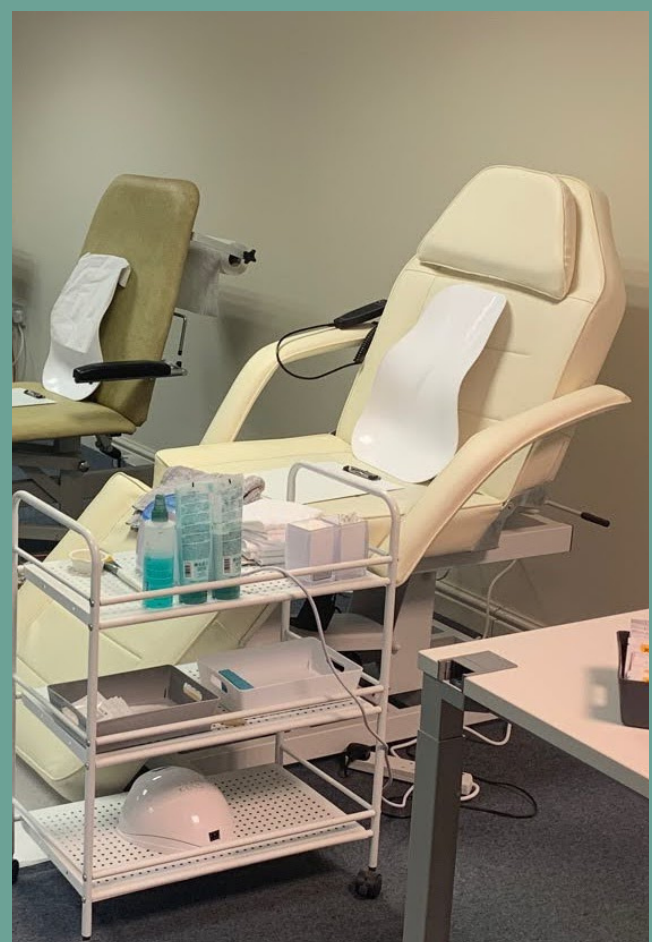
What's Included?
