There are a variety of unique opportunities that will be offered to Youth members including conferences, trainings, and some travel. With that being said, there are some requirements and agreements you and your student must sign in order for your child to participate.

Youth Code of Conduct

- Only students who have attended a minimum 75% of all meetings **will be considered** to be taken to events
 - There will be make-up meeting opportunities available
- If a student cannot attend a meeting or event, they agree to communicate that with one of the adult advisors
- Students agree to conduct themselves in a professional manner
- Students agree to listen and participate respectfully with one another
- Students agree not to use tobacco, marijuana, alcohol, e-cigarette or vapor devices, or other illegal substances while participating in MSTEPP Youth
