

# Livestock Farm Evacuation Considerations

Alberta Edition – Wildfire, Flood & Rural Response Delays

## Evacuation Decision & Timing

- Clear wildfire/flood trigger thresholds defined
- Early evacuation policy (leave before road closure)
- Monitoring of weather and fire alerts

## Transportation & Movement

- Livestock trailer maintained and fuelled
- Loading plan with assigned responsibilities
- Hauling agreements with neighbouring farms
- Portable panels and halters available

## Animal Identification & Records

- Livestock inventory with tag numbers
- Photos for proof of ownership
- Vaccination and health records accessible
- Insurance documentation accessible

## Destination & Welfare Planning

- Pre-identified evacuation sites
- 72-hour feed and water transport plan
- Biosecurity considerations for relocation
- Shade and shelter arrangements

## Financial & Liability Considerations

- Livestock insurance verified
- Equipment inventory documented
- Emergency expense reserve
- Record of contractual livestock obligations
