Failure to attend a briefing disqualifies your boat from the poker run.

BOAT CLASSES

BLACK – 80+ MPH * Take off first ORANGE 50-80 MPH BLUE 30-50 MPH WHITE UP TO 30 MPH

*The horn will sound to signal each class to take off (approx 3-5 mins each class)





SAFETY GUIDELINES

ALCOHOL POLICY

Captains may not consume alcohol until the run is over and you've returned to the final stop. You'll have plenty of time to celebrate later. Please also keep a close eye on your passengers - there's much movement on docks and boats, and we're operating heavy machinery.

GENERAL SAFETY GUIDELINES

All boaters must comply with **Transport Canada's Boating Requirements.**

HIGH-PERFORMANCE BOATS

- All passengers and drivers must wear certified life jackets while boats are underway.
- Kill switch lanyards must be worn by drivers at all times.
- Safety harnesses must be worn if your boat is equipped with them.

ADDITIONAL SAFETY NOTES

- Safety checks: Random safety inspections will take place throughout the day.
- Ensure your vessel is equipped with all required safety gear and has the appropriate number of life jackets on board.
- Water levels are low this year stay alert for floating debris, deadheads, rocks, and shallow areas.
- Respect all No Wake Zones and posted speed limits. We want to be good neighbours and maintain the ability to host future events.

DOCKING ETIQUETTE

- Approach docks slowly with lines and bumpers prepped on both sides.
- Be ready to raft off and assist neighbouring boats with tying up.
- Raft off similar-sized boats when possible.
- Be patient. Use **neutral often** slow is smooth, and smooth is safe.

SPEED AWARENESS AND BOAT ETIQUETTE

- Many participants are new to poker runs expect boats of various sizes and speeds.
- Stay aware of your surroundings and check frequently for traffic around and behind you.
- Maintain a safe, consistent path, and only change lanes when absolutely safe.
- High-performance catamarans often have limited maneuverability at low speeds and need wide turns.
- Boats travelling over 100+ mph can close distances quickly - stay alert at all times.

DOCKING ETIQUETTE

- Approach docks slowly with lines and bumpers prepped on both sides.
- Be ready to raft off and assist neighbouring boats with tying up.
- Raft off similar-sized boats when possible.
- Be patient. Use neutral often slow is smooth, and smooth is safe.

WINDSOR YACHT CLUB



Radio to Channel 68. Follow directions of the Harbour Master for well assignment – Please advise if you are arriving for lunch or a short chip stop. Be prepared to raft off in the EAST Harbour.

COLLECT A MINIMUM OF 5 CHIPS FROM 7 STOPS

POKER CHIP COLLECTION STOPS

MITCHELL'S BAY



37' Larson Boat will be anchored in deep water closer to Grassy—look for the Shake the Lake Sign.
Approach slowly for a rolling stop and signal how many chips you need as you approach.

HARBOUR HOUSE



Radio to Channel 68. Follow directions of Lakeview Marina/City Windsor staff for well assignment. Larger boats will need to park on wall. Plan to work to Harbour House to collect your chip.

SANDBAR WATERFRONT GRILL



Follow direction of dock staff. Please advise dock staff if you had selected Sandbar for lunch, or are just arriving for a chip stop. They will provide docking space accordingly. Please be aware you may need to raft off depending on time of day. Be prepared with all fenders and ropes.

SPLASHBANAS AT BELLE RIVER



Will be parked in semi-deep water WEST of Belle River beach. Look for the large duck. This is a great spot to drop anchor, hop in the lake, and enjoy the Splash Banas. Don't forget to collect your chip while you're there.

RUSCOM RIVER BARGE



Will be parked out front of Ruscom Conservation area. The barge is steel – Approach slowly for a rolling stop only on the side where there are tire fenders. Chip will be passed via Fishing Net. Remain in neutral and take off very slowly as to not disturb the band. Where possible, a swim to the chip is preferred.

LIGHTHOUSE COVE'S LANDING



Park along the wall out front of the patio, all the way down to Cove's Marina. If the wall is full, be aware you may need to raft off of fellow boaters. Please have all fenders out and ropes ready and help your neighbours.



POKER RUN RULES & PRIZES

CHIP EXCHANGE BETWEEN 4:30 P.M. AND 7:30 P.M. AT SANDBAR

Each player must collect a minimum of 5 uniquely coloured poker chips from the designated chip stops between 11:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Once you have all 5 chips, head to The Sandbar to exchange them for your poker hand and compete for the highest-ranking hand.

Players then have ONE opportunity to improve their hand:

Missed a stop? Or want to increase your odds of winning by exchanging a card? Buy a card — maximum one time only. PURCHASE 1 CARD – \$50.00

The player with the best 5-card poker hand at the end wins.

HAND RANKING (HIGH TO LOW

- 1.Royal Flush: A♠ K♠ Q♠ J♠ 10♠
- 2. Straight Flush: Five consecutive cards of the same suit (e.g., 9 8 7 6 5 6)
- Four of a Kind: Four cards of the same rank
 (e.g., J♦ J♠ J♣ J♥ 7♠)
- 4. Full House: Three of a kind + a pair (e.g., 8♣ 8♠ 8♠ 4♥ 4♠)
- 5. Flush: Five cards of the same suit (e.g., K♠ 10♠ 8♠ 4♠ 2♠)
- 6. Straight: Five consecutive cards, mixed suits (e.g., $6 \clubsuit 5 \diamondsuit 4 \spadesuit 3 \spadesuit 2 \heartsuit$)
- 7. Three of a Kind: Three cards of the same rank
- 8. Two Pair: Two different pairs
- 9. One Pair: One pair
- 10. High Card: If no other hand is made, highest card wins

OFFICIAL RULES

- 1. Must be a registered full-day participant
- 2. Collect 5 unique-coloured chips from different stops
- 3. Collect chips between 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- 4. Exchange chips for cards between 4:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. at Sandbar
- 5. No cards or chips accepted after the deadline
- 6. All cards will be dealt and recorded
- 7. Top 3 winners will be annouced before 10:00p .m
