THINGS TO KNOW

DBE firms must be pre-qualified in accordance with the requirements of the state where the project is located

- ✓ To increase opportunities for DBE firms
- ✓ To bring together certified DBEs and prime contractors
- ✓ To create access to a larger pool of projects, ultimately helping DBE firms to become prime contractors

DETAILS OF THE DEAL

- The initial length of the agreement is one year, beginning July 1, 2018, with the option to extend it for an additional four years
- All DBEs operating under the agreement are subject to all policies, statutes and regulations, including the DBE regulations under 49 C.F.R. Part 26
- The agreement does not grant interstate certification
- DBE firms must comply with all applicable local and state guidance, statutes, regulations and policies applicable to the work performed in the state where the project takes place
