1. The birds come first: the well-being of the birds is our priority.
2. We are polite and cordial with other birders.
3. Silence is primordial to having a pleasant experience.
4. We minimize the use of audio and electronic media to attract the birds.
5. We put our cellphones in silent mode.
6. In the field, we keep conversations to a minimum and at a low voice.
7. When possible, we reduce our ecological footprint by travelling in fewer vehicles.
8. We use existing trails and roads.
9. We are patient and take our time observing and appreciating the birds.
10. We bring back all waste generated during the trip, and dispose of it properly.
11. We leave the sites the same or better than how we found them.
12. We support the conservation efforts of the natural spaces we visit.
