

Cabin Fever Quilt Along

Part 2: Shoo Fly

Shoo Fly is another nine-patch block, with identical building blocks to the Friendship Star. There are two, 6-1/2 inch Shoo Fly blocks in the quilt.

Building Blocks: This block is a nine-patch, so there are nine squares, each 2-1/2” **unfinished**.

4 squares neutral

4 squares HST, scrap/neutral

1 square scrap

Cutting: (These cutting instructions will make the Half Square Triangles (HST) oversized. They will need to be cut down using the Tucker Trimmer or another square ruler.)

Scrap 1: Two squares, 3-1/4”

Scrap 2: One square, 2-1/2”

Neutral: Two squares, 3-1/4”; four squares, 2-1/2”

Construction: Follow the instructions for the Friendship Star to construct the block. Use the photo to help you lay out the building blocks in the correct positions. The block will be 6-1/2” unfinished.
