National PGR Safety Statement



The Board of Directors of the Patriot Guard Riders directs all State Captains to instruct all Ride Captains on the following:

- That all local laws, including those governing traffic for the state, county or community in which a PGR mission is being conducted be complied with.
- Road Guarding, disregarding traffic signs or signals, blocking or redirecting traffic is prohibited.
- Directions and requests from law enforcement officers who are present at a mission should be obeyed, provided the request can be safely executed.

It is, therefore, the responsibility of each State Captain to be familiar with the laws of your state. Further, it is the responsibility of Ride Captains to strictly adhere to the State Captain's instructions AND to be familiar with any laws in the county or community in which the mission is conducted that may differ from the state's laws.

Furthermore, it is compulsory that a Safety Briefing be conducted by the Ride Captain or their designated representative prior to ALL missions including ALL elements of multifaceted missions. The safety briefing will at a minimum include the following statements:

- Every person participating in today's mission does so solely at their own risk and under their own responsibility.
- Every rider participating in today's mission is responsible to provide their own insurance coverage.
