

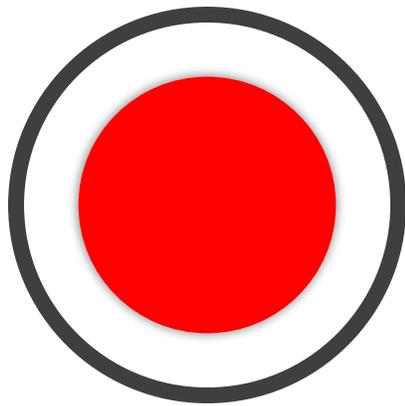

DATA MANAGEMENT PAIN POINTS

PAIN #1

Lack of proper documentation about data

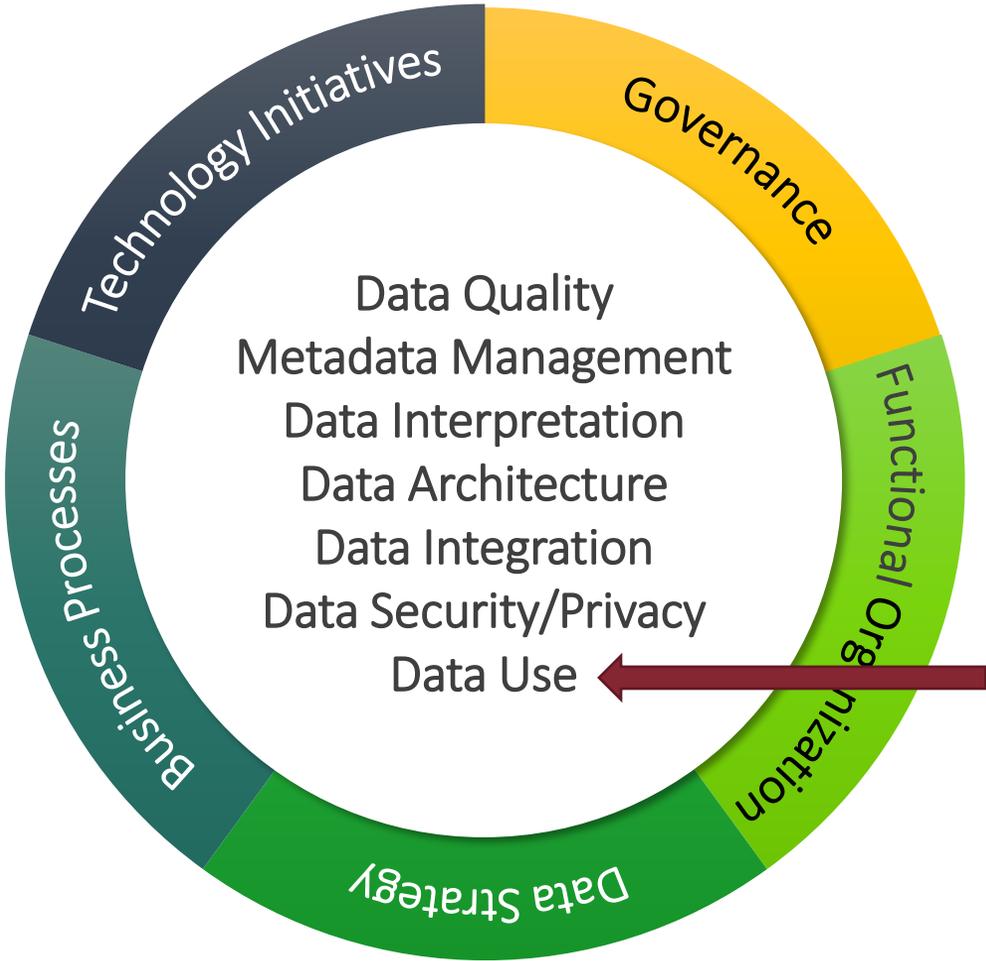
PAIN #2

Errors in the data discovered by users

PAIN #3

Data contents do not make sense to users.

THE WORLD OF DATA MANAGEMENT



Data Management: “The development, execution, and supervision of plans, policies, programs, and practices that deliver, control, protect, and enhance the value of data and information assets throughout their lifecycles.”

(DAMA-DMBOK 2nd ed.)

WHAT DO WE MEAN BY “QUALITY”?

“In technical usage, ‘quality’ can have two meanings:

1. the characteristics of a product or service that bear on its ability to **satisfy stated or implied needs**;
2. a product or service **free of deficiencies.**”

Compliance with some set of criteria, standards, or requirements

Noncompliance of standards or requirements = Deficiency, Defect

Perfect quality = Complete absence of defects

Data Cleansing ≠ Data Quality

Activity, task

Characteristic, state

DIMENSIONS OF DATA QUALITY

COMPLETENESS

- How populated/complete is it?

VALIDITY

- Are the values technically valid?

ACCURACY

- Is it free of errors?

CONSISTENCY

- Is it free of discrepancies?

INTEGRITY

- Is it coherent?

TIMELINESS

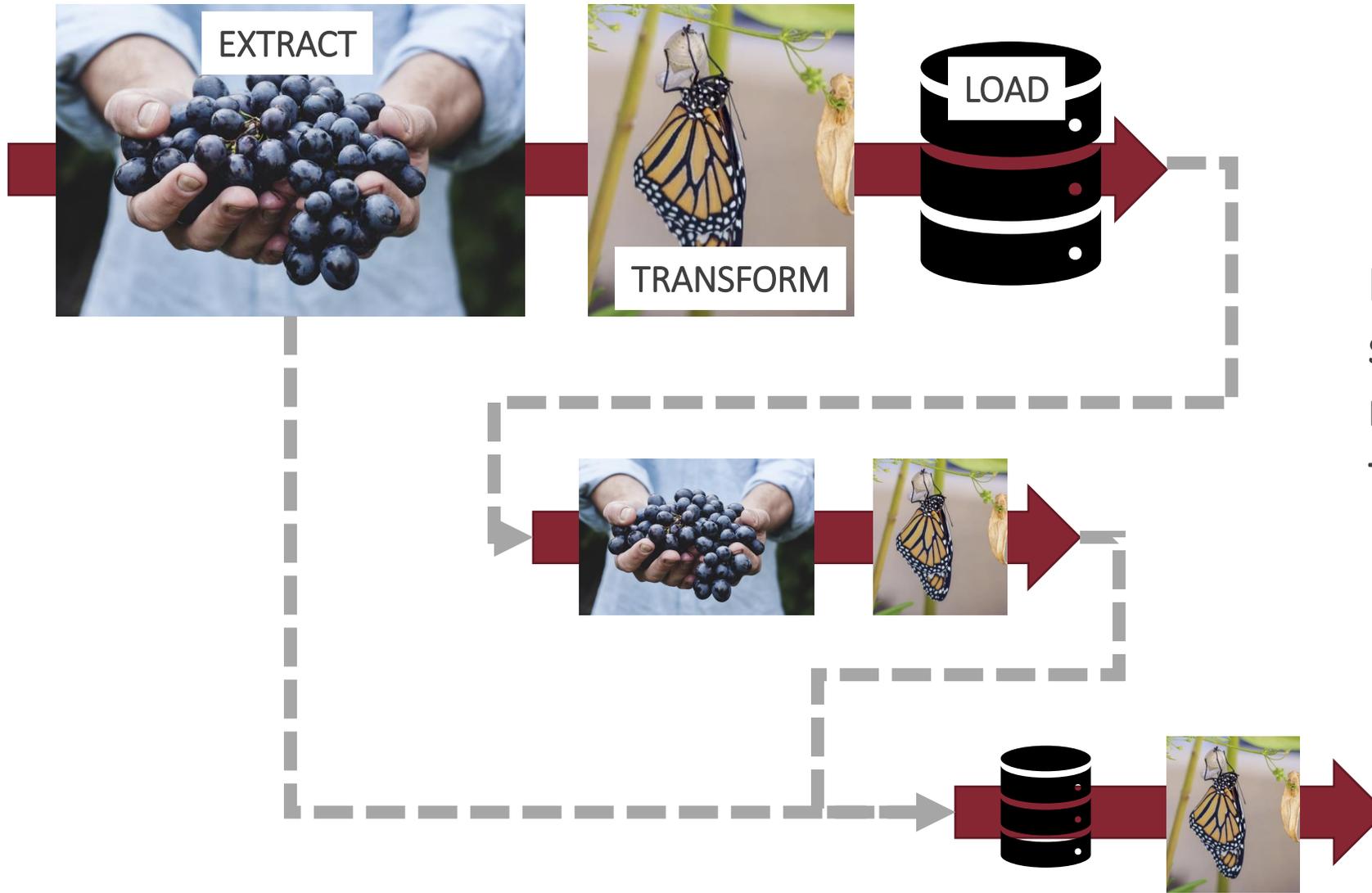
- Does it reflect the timing of interest (current and historical)?

UNIQUENESS

- Is it free of duplications and fragmentations?

REASONABILITY

- Does it reasonably reflect the intent and the reality?



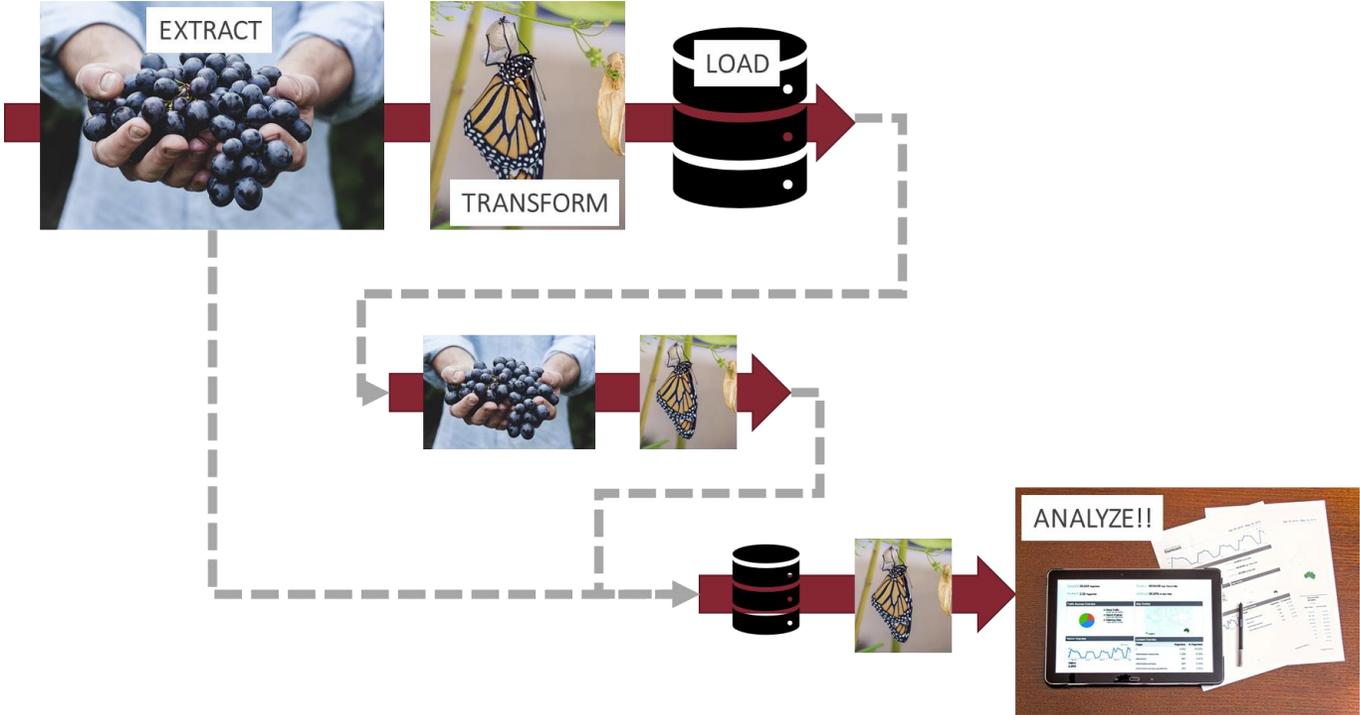
Each one of these steps presents multiple opportunities for data defects.



- COMPLETENESS
- VALIDITY
- ACCURACY
- CONSISTENCY
- INTEGRITY
- TIMELINESS
- UNIQUENESS
- REASONABILITY

Technology-led data quality: custody-centric (logic over content)

- Can address each dimension only partially.
- Reasonability is rarely addressed.



User-led (including analytics-led) data quality: reactive and incomplete

- Can address quality only when it gets to them.
- Data quality is a means to an end, not the end itself.

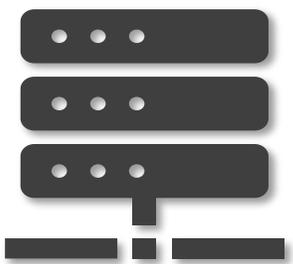
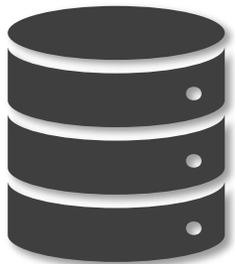
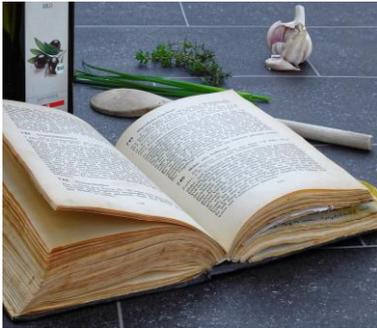

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?



- Advocate for establishing a proper data function.
- Continue to be diligent about the data you do see.
 - Technology: Learn as much as you can about the data content and how that relates to reality from the users' perspective.
 - Analytics: Learn about data quality methodologies to help identify problems, albeit reactively.
 - >At the minimum: Perform a data audit for every project data you receive, as soon as you receive it.

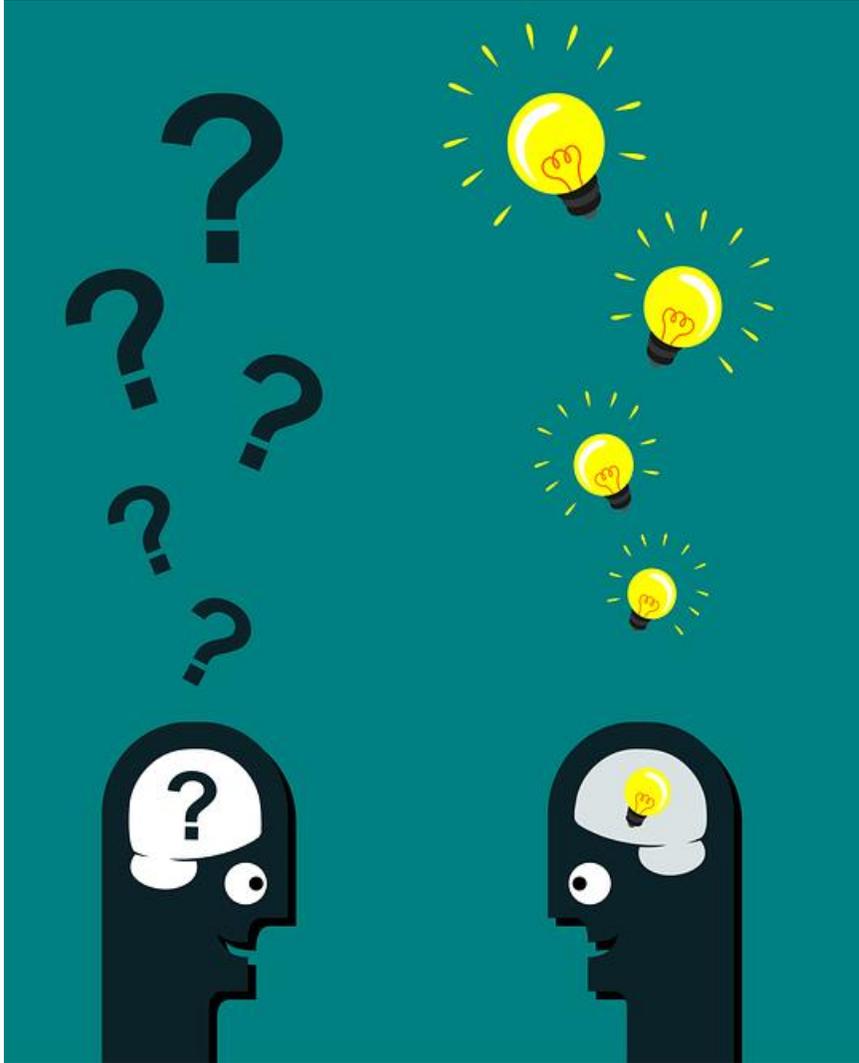
