

#### 2024 Bonnyville Karate Tournament

Dear Instructors,

I am pleased to invite you and your students to the Shito-Ryu Kyokai Karate-Do, North-East Karate Championships. This year Bonnyville has the honor of hosting this event at the Centennial Center Bonnyville (4313 50th avenue) in on Saturday, November 23, 2024. Our events have been successful due to the tremendous support shown by dedicated individuals such as yourself and your members.

On Saturday November 23<sup>rd</sup> we will run individual kata, kobudo and kumite competition for students of all ranks and ages. On Sunday November 24 we will host a small Batto-Do competition at the Dojo 5024 50 Ave. for those interested. A specific Kata list will not be provided however competitors will be expected to perform Kata appropriate for their rank. Blue belts or higher will be required to do a different Kata in each round as they advance. Kobudo competitors may repeat the same kata each round.

All kumite events will be double elimination in order to provide greater opportunity for all competitors. Kumite matches will run for two minutes or 3 points in all kyu level events. Black and red belt events will feature 3 minute / 3 full points or 6 half-point matches. Black and Red belt kata and Kobudo events will use the flag method, however contestants shall perform their kata individually and then the judges shall render their decision. In all other events, competitors shall perform their kata simultaneously.

All kumite events will be free-style kumite except for adult white and yellow belts. They will engage in ippon kumite. Please see the division chart for complete details. Juniors under the age of 14 years will be divided into size-appropriate categories on the day of the tournament to ensure the fairest groupings possible. **Please note** that each grouping will complete in kata and then kumite. We expect Junior divisions to be fully completed by noon or 1:00 p.m. at the latest.

I look forward to your participation in this tournament and to another great event. As in the past, safety will be our prime concern and all officials will be vigilant of dangerous or disrespectful conduct and to ensure fairness in all events.

### 2024 SHITO-RYU KARATE-DO KYOKAI KARATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Date: Saturday, November 23, 2024

**Location: Centennial Center Field House**

Time: Tournament begins at 10:00 a.m. sharp!

Registration: 8:30 a.m. (Multiple registration tables in use)

Fee: \$40 (one event or more)

Family (additional members pay \$25 each)

**Events:** Individual Kata, Kumite. and Kobudo, Batto, laido.

Awards: Medallions for all top three place finishers. Trophies for

Club awards

Matches: All coloured belt matches shall be two-minutes / 3

points.

Black (red) belt matches shall be 3 minutes / 3 full

points or 6 half-points.

All kumite events will be double elimination.

#### Kata:

Although there is no restriction on which kata may be performed, contestants are advised to perform a kata, appropriate to their belt level.

Beginner level to 5<sup>th</sup> kyu (purple belt) may repeat the same kata if they chose. 4<sup>th</sup> kyu (Blue belt) and higher must perform a different kata as they advance.

Kata competition will use the flag system.

Kobudo may use the point system. Black belt level must perform traditional kata; no kihon kata. Same kobudo kata may be repeated.

Batto and Iai – Competition on Sunday Nov. 24 at Bonnyville Dojo. Contestants must perform "Mae and two other kata.

Kit: Each competitor is responsible for arriving at the tournament with a complete Kit, which includes a white, traditional karate-gi (free of any markings other a dojo crest), a belt, white only hand protectors, groin protector, tooth guard.

Regular glasses and jewelry may <u>not</u> be worn during kumite events under any circumstances. Sport type safety glasses permitted!

Karate-gis must be clean and in good repair. Sleeves and pants must be properly cut and hemmed and cannot be rolled up. Tee shirts or other garments worn under the gi must be pure white in colour only!

Officials: Black belts will be asked to assist with officiating and time / score keeping.

Formal officiating attire must be worn and will be supplied.

Officials must wear their karate-gi. A Haori jacket will be supplied.

Officials must have their own whistle.

Kata divisions will be judged by the flag/single bracket format. Blue Belt and above must perform a different kata for each advancement in the bracket. Divisions may be combined &/or eliminated as required.

Kumite Divisions will be **Double Elimination**, 2 Min-Stop Time or 3 Full Points for all kyu levels. Divisions may be combined &/or eliminated as required. We may divide the Junior girls & boys depending on numbers. Excessive head contact (anything beyond a light touch), including neck and throat will lead to disqualification. Excessive body contact will also be penalized and may result in disqualification at the discretion of the officials.

Kobudo divisions are planned to be judged by the flag system however, if we are running against the clock (late) we may use the traditional point system. Divisions may be combined &/or eliminated as required.

**TAMASHIGIRI** All cutting matches will run head to head with a show of flags.

Competitors below Shodan will require instructors approval to participate

in the cutting events.

**TEAM MATCHES:** Teams will consist of three members cutting two cuts each Roku Dan giri.

**KATA:** Kata divisions will include Kome Kata, Toyama Ryu Kata, Sushin-ryu

Kata and Iai-Do Kata. Competitors may only enter one Kata division and not mix Kata. All competitors must perform a rank appropriate kata and begin with the first Kata of the set. Kata will be head-to-head & decided

by a show of flags.
