Dur	2+ DISTINCT PERSONALITY STATES <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May be “experience of possession”</li> <li>• Discontinuous sense of self + agency</li> <li>• Alterations in affect, behavior, consciousness, memory, perception, cognition, or sensory-motor function</li> </ul>	INABILITY TO RECALL PERSONAL INFO <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Usually traumatic/stressful nature</li> <li>• Not ordinary forgetting</li> </ul>	Either or both: <b>DEPERSONALIZATION</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unreality, detachment or being an outside observer to one’s thoughts, feelings, sensations, body or actions</li> </ul> <b>DEREALIZATION</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unreality, detachment to surroundings</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does not meet any full criteria</li> <li>• Choose TO communicate specific reason</li> </ul> 1. Chronic and recurrent syndromes of mixed dissociative symptoms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Identity disturbance</li> <li>- Less-than-mark discontinuity of self/agency</li> <li>- No dissociative amnesia</li> </ul> 2. Identity disturbance due to prolonged and intense coercive persuasion           3. Acute dissociative reactions to stressful events <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Typically &lt;1 mos (hours-days)</li> </ul> 4. Dissociative trance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- With minor stereotyped behaviors</li> <li>- Unaware, cannot control</li> <li>- Transient paralysis/LOC</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does not meet any full criteria</li> <li>• Choose NOT to communicate specific reason</li> <li>• Insufficient information for dx</li> </ul>
