In June we had some sad news that Pastor Ted Alleman passed away. We attended Rhema Bible Training Center together in 1976 and remained friends all our life. Pastor Ted was one of the first Directors of Reaching the World and has always been a part of our ministry.

I attended his memorial service in New Jersey and shared about our ministry together. Pastor Ted invited us to speak at a conference with him in Northern India in 1985 where we met the Pastors from Myanmar who had travelled 14 days to get to the conference. Our mission projects in Myanmar came from that first meeting at the conference. Thirty years later we have established long term mission projects with a Bible College, churches and two Children’s Homes. Our connection to Myanmar came from Pastor Ted’s invitation. He will be greatly missed but we know that he is with the Lord.

Myanmar Report:

The children’s Home has begun their new school year and they have all received new school uniforms and school supplies to start school.

The church in Mandalay is growing and increasing steadily. This past month five new believers were baptized. This is a very big step for them as many of their families disown them for becoming Christians and leaving Buddhism.
