#1 - Here is a wine offering intense aromas of red stone fruits and berries, accented by notes of violets and sweet tobacco. The medium-bodied palate boasts excellent structure, with vibrant acidity and soft yet firm tannins providing a perfect framework for the wine's rich fruit flavors. Tastes of Bing cherry, strawberries, and a touch of tart raspberry are all beautifully integrated, leading to a savory, lingering finish.

#2 - Castello di Ama feels like a scene from a timeless fairytale – yet it also doubles as a hub for contemporary art. To mark the 25th anniversary of their art collection, they created a special label: a tribute to wine, the immovable presence that gives meaning to and inspires so many works of art. This wine expresses the archetype of pure pleasure that their terroir can offer. A simple sip, grounded in a deep dedication to their place.

#3 - This winery is one of the smallest in Barbaresco and it's owner, Danilo, is a true rebel – an anarchist winemaker with a passion for “doodling,” which is why all the labels are personally designed by him. This is a captivating expression of Nebbiolo, showing the elegance and complexity this renowned region is known for. It invites you in with aromas of ripe red berries, rose petals, and subtle hints of earthy tobacco and spice.

#4 - The estate is renowned for its specialty, Sfursat, a wine made from grapes carefully harvested by skilled pickers and then dried for 100 days in the cool, dry alpine air. Crafted from Nebbiolo, locally known as Chiavennasca, this wine blends strength and elegance in a remarkable way. Flavors of dried fruit, tobacco, and spices explode on the palate, culminating in a long, persistent finish that leaves a lasting, pleasing impression.

#5 - In 1830 the Tasca brothers purchased Tenuta Regaleali, a green oasis in the center of Sicily in the county of Sclafani. Aromas of ripe banana and smooth white chocolate seamlessly merge with hints of honey and vanilla. The palate delivers a full-bodied entry with a rich texture that envelops the mouth. A perfect pairing for seafood dishes.
