<i>13% Alcohol, Drink: Now</i></p> | <p>#1 - Made in less than 3500 bottles and available to our members before the rest of the world! The bouquet is intense yet delicate while the palate is dry, full-bodied and resilient. As it ages, it will become more refined with a full and harmonious flavor. A sweet cherry and beef flavor on the mid-palate followed by a tart, moderately tannic finish. Best served with pork tenderloin or lamb.</p> <p>#2 - This 2009 vintage was listed on Wine Spectator's Top 100 wines! It has an ethereal bouquet of violets, cherries, and wood which fills the nose. On the palate, it is dry, harmonious, and fruity with a velvety, elegant texture and a long finish. Traditionally paired with wild boar but can accompany any game meat and is great with aged cheeses. This is a cellar-worthy wine with a special back label!</p> <p>#3 - Aromas of wet earth and a hint of truffle lift out of the glass. The simple yet vivacious palate offers small red berries and a hint of mocha alongside vigorous acidity and smooth tannins. This wine is fruity with cherry and strawberry notes, slightly spicy with hints of black pepper. Perfect with meat, ripe cheese or pasta!</p> <p>#4 - A rare wine that is new to the market and unavailable throughout most of the world. The producer planted the vines in 2010, thus this is the newest addition to their portfolio. With an intense ruby red color, notes of red fruits and spicy pink pepper, the winemaker perfectly balances the aspects of fruit and soil.</p> <p>#5 - Only 500 bottles were made available in Italy and we got them for our club! Intense straw yellow color. On the nose is a bouquet of poutpourri and green tea with light notes of white pulp fruits and flint. The "Studio" is a perfect marriage of two local grape varieties: a wine distinctly floral and nutty, with great freshness and balance. 92 points from Suckling and 3 bicchieri from Gambero Rosso!</p> |
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
