	#1 - 2022 Fagnani Rosso 100% Sangiovese Rosso di Montalcino DOC Drink: now - 2027	#1 - We've selected a wine with character that fully expresses the simplicity of a unique and extraordinary terroir. This is an intense ruby red wine. Good structure and flavor, in the mouth it is clean and elegant, with a retro taste of wild berries such as blueberries, currants, raspberries and strawberries. The perfume is elegant and intense. It goes well with first courses with meat sauce, roasted white meat, fresh and medium-aged cheeses.		
	#2 - 2021 Masseria Altemura 100% Primitivo Primitivo di Manduria DOC Drink: now - 2030	#2 - Altemura means "high walls" and this wine was named in reference to the high, stone walls, which were used to protect the estate from invaders over the centuries. The nose shows peppery notes, combined with more complex aromas of wild berries, forest floor, and cloves. A red wine of great enveloping smoothness and intensity. Majestic, powerful and velvety, where the softness is sustained by elegant tannins.		
	#3 - 2021 Goretti Le Mura Saracene Sangiovese, Merlot & Sagrantino Montefalco Rosso DOC Drink: 2025 - 2032	#3 - The Goretti estate stands on a hilly area near Perugia. The location is key for the diurnal temperatures which, together with the fertile Umbrian soil, give life to these exclusive vineyards. This wine is complex, very rich. A touch of ripe red fruit and mature black-fruit, with spicy nuances of cocoa, vanilla, licorice and cinnamon aromas. Medium-bodied, with a perfect harmony between the coffee and tobacco nuances.		
	#4 - 2022 Santa Cristina Fattoria le Maestrelle Merlot, Syrah & Sangiovese Toscana IGT Drink: now	#4 - A modern red wine with distinctive personality that expresses a strong connection with its native Tuscan territory in a contemporary interpretation. Ruby red in color with purplish hues. Its intense and complex nose offers notes of ripe red fruit, well integrated with notes of juniper berries, mint, vanilla and coffee. On the palate it is well-balanced, supple, savory with a complex finish that brings back aromas perceived on the nose.
