DESCRIPTION

#1 - Made exclusively from grapes grown in the Tenuta di Lilliano vineyards. Anagallis is named after a small orange flower which is very common in the Chianti area. Deep red color, intense, almost impenetrable, with rich tones. Good structure, powerful and persistent, with lively and responsive tannins, well contrasted by the acidity that cools down the long finish. Pair with red meat.

#2 - Villa Rosa is situated between the hills of Castellina in Chianti, and extends over 126 hectares. The winery delineates three, distinct areas based on their oenological potential, where Sangiovese is the best adapted and thus, king. The color is lively and rarefied, a prelude to an extremely elegant nose, characterized by floral notes that overlap and blend with delicate fruity and light spicy notes.

#3 - Only produced in the best years, with a maximum production of 900 bottles! The 2015 label was created by the famous Italian artist, Franco Menicagli. This beauty has intense and complex aromas of blackberry, blueberry and ripe cherry, mulberry, rose and mild toasted tones. Well balanced, silky tannins with an elegant, long finish. Pair with veal shank to fully appreciate this stunning wine.

#4 - Cabreo "Black" is the result of Ambrogio Folonari's great dream after his many journeys to Burgundy. Bright red color with dark shadows. An elegant wine with red fruits and signs of burned incense. In the mouth are blueberries, black chocolate, sweet tannins and a persistent finish. Extraordinarily classy.

#5 - A dry, warm and soft wine with a good match between high levels of alcohol and high content in organic acids. It has no edges but the texture is balanced and very persistent. It is intense and complex on the nose: in the early years there are fruity smells reminiscent of pear, peach and floral smells such as acacia flowers.
