- #1** - An intense wine with a perfect combination of authenticity and inspiration, following the criterions of the winery's "Maestro of Life" Giovanni Lebole, "Giannetto." On the nose an intense and vinous aroma with notes of ripe red fruits and spices. Round, sapid, persistent yet also soft and velvety with smooth tannins. Pair with dishes of Tuscan tradition, red meat or mature cheeses.
- #2** - Maggiarino comes from the vineyards of the eponymous farm, one of the most renowned areas on the La Braccessa estate. A well-balanced wine that expresses the grape variety's personality, typical of the historic Nobile territory. Violets, red fruit and vanilla form its complex aromatic profile. On the palate it is supple, balanced and silky sustained by excellent freshness. *94 Wine Enthusiast.*
- #3** - With only 2700 bottles produced, the wine is "wild and amazing" on the nose with crystal-clear aromas of lavender, before the bay leaves, Thai basil, cloves and a touch of vanilla come into play. Medium to full body, incredibly edgy acidity and layer after layer of pure blue fruits. An outstanding wine with few parallels in Italy. Pair with grilled salmon or mild cheeses. *97 James Suckling, 93 Robert Parker.*
- #4** - A classic style Barolo. Excellent structure, harmony and elegance. Soft tannins and balanced fruit. Approachable, but with a very long aging potential. Complex aromas of smoke, ash and dark fruits with a precision and intensity. *All vintages received 94+ from James Suckling and 92+ from Wine Advocate.*
- #5** - This wine is known at the winery as "Il Mario" and is the best quality possible of Schiopetto wines. Rich and dynamic, the fruity notes of the Friulano blend with icy and mineral notes of the Riesling, creating a balance of great elegance and personality. Excellent with first courses, fish, soups and white meats
