	#1 - 2018 Le Mortelle 'Poggio alle Nane' Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon & Carménère Maremma Toscana DOC Drink: now - 2035	#1 - Poggio alle Nane is a wine of great aromatic complexity with an elegant tannic structure. The grapes comes from a wine growing area well known for its production of high quality wines, an area in which terroir is king. On the nose spicy, balsamic scents of black pepper, cloves and licorice merge with notes of ripe dark fruit such as blueberries. Its palate is rich, elegant and mouth-filling with vibrant tannins.			
	#2 - 2016 Poggio Landi 'Chiuso del Lupo' Brunello 100% Sangiovese Brunello di Montalcino DOCG Drink: 2022 - 2040	#2 - Exceptional and elegant: all the characteristics of the best Brunello di Montalcino are expressed in the new Cru of Brunello. Deep ruby red with garnet reflections, the nose expresses hints of licorice and black cherry, with deep references of wild berries and leather. The sip releases impetuous tannins of great strength and persistence. Pair with braised meats and earthy flavors like truffles.			
	#3 - 2018 Castello di Bossi Pinot Nero 100% Pinot Nero Toscana IGT Drink: now - 2040	#3 - Castello di Bossi is located in the southern half of Chianti Classico and their decision to begin growing Pinot Nero culminated in a collaboration with Marco Molesini to create this proprietary wine for you, his club members! It offers an authentic and typical expression of its variety with a strong territorial character. On the nose delicate aromas of spices, violets and small red fruit. Its palate is supple and savory with silky tannins and distinctive characteristics that enhance its profile.
