PROVIDE CLEAR COPIES OF PROOF DOCUMENTS FOR BIRTHS AND RESIDENCES

Examples of acceptable documents:

- *Birth certificates* of child and both parents for each generation
- *Marriage record* for parents for each generation
- *Government census record* proving residence for First Families of Licking County, Settlers and Builders of Ohio, and Century Families of Ohio.
- The first *federal census* that included the area of present-day Ohio was taken in **1800** as part of the Northwest Territory census. Ohio later became a state in 1803 so the first official U.S. census of the legally established state was taken in **1810**.
- For the Northwest Territory, Ohio was a frontier territory (part of the Northwest Territory). Land ownership and taxation were tracked. Research *tax and land records*. The *Bureau of Land Management* provides information on *land patents, surveys and sales* in the Ohio territory. The oldest counties, such as Washington, Hamilton and Ross, may have *tax records, land deeds or transfer records*. Also keep *church and military records* in mind. Look for *enlistments, militia muster rolls or pension files* related to the Northwest Indian War (1785-1795) and the War of 1812 as they may require prior area residency.
