- ▲ To seek and initiate projects, such as the establishment and/or maintenance of public gardens, that require the time, knowledge, skills, etc. of LIMG members

Selection Process: The nomination form will be available for download on the LIMG website and at the October LIMG meeting. Nominations may be submitted in one of two ways:
