

ACOLYTES AND READERS NEEDED!

ACOLYTES: Acolytes at Salem Lutheran Church are a very important part of our worship experience. Acolytes, as light bearers, symbolically bring the light of Christ into the worship service at the beginning of worship and at the end of worship take Christ's light out into the world -which is why the Acolyte

Team is so special. Acolytes do NOT need to robe up unless there is a special worship service (unless they would like to).

READERS: We need people (adults or children) to read the lessons during worship. You can read one or both.


