


Mandy moved to adjourn, Pastor Sue seconded. Motion passed.

RIC UPDATE

Since last fall, Salem been working through the discernment process to determine whether Salem should become a Reconciling in Christ (RIC) church (see the RIC Q&A sheet for more information). One of the requirements for becoming an RIC church is the development of a Welcome Statement – one that affirms our commitment to welcoming all people, especially those who have been historically marginalized by the Church.

At our January congregational meeting, we shared a draft version of this Welcome Statement, received some feedback, and have made some small revisions based on that input:

Throughout its history, Salem Lutheran Church in Moline, Illinois has striven to be "The Welcome Place," and continues to welcome all people, honoring our human differences of race, color, sex, gender, age, national origin, LGBTQIA+ identity, religious tradition, marital status, immigration status, personal socio-economic circumstances, or being differently-abled. We reject all that divides us as people of God, and pledge to continue to cherish, support and nurture all of God's beloved children, through prayer, education, study and fellowship. - Christ calls us to unity and wholeness, and we joyfully invite all to join us, especially those who seek a deeper relationship with God and anyone who has been excluded or hurt by the Church in the past. We seek to help our broken world through love for and service to one another, our neighbor, our community, and our world, all in the name of Jesus Christ. No matter where you find yourself in life, know that you are loved at Salem.

There is a copy of the updated statement in the Auditorium, and we invite your feedback using the post-it notes on the table by the statement. Please let us know what you appreciate about the statement and/or what you'd like to see changed. You're welcome to sign your post-it notes or keep your feedback anonymous, if you prefer. You are also welcome to share feedback with any of the RIC Committee members.

While we know it may not be possible to craft a statement that reflects the exact wording preferred by every member, we are committed to considering all feedback carefully as we continue revising the statement into one that we can all be proud to share with the world. We anticipate a vote on both the Welcome Statement and the decision to become an RIC church at our June Congregational Meeting.
