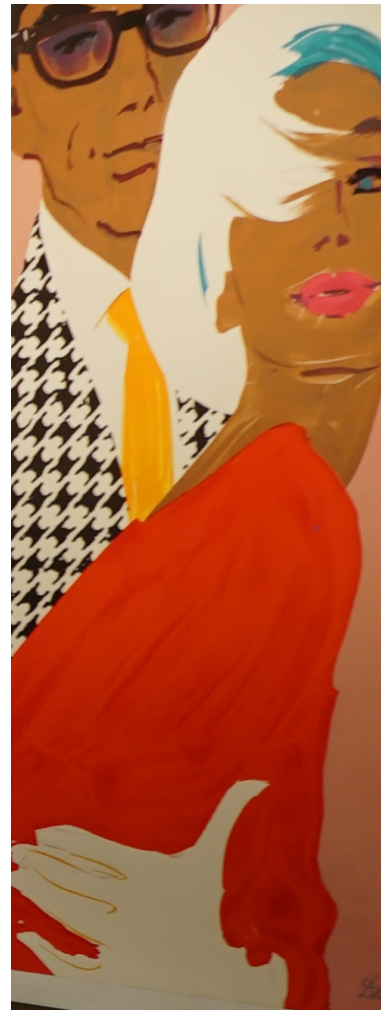

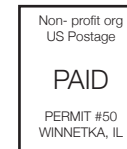

Dissecting the Layers of Designing a Livable Luxury Home

Meg Caswell began her design career the moment she decided not to attend law school. After earning a degree in criminology, she enrolled at The Art Institute of Chicago, where she completed her BFA in interior architecture. She worked for Ralph Lauren Home, but quickly set out on her own with the opening of the Design Shoppe. In 2011, she gained national attention as a top interior designer when she won season 6 of HGTV's Design Star and went on to host her own show for HGTV, Meg's Great Rooms. During her A+M presentation, "Dissecting the Layers of Designing a Livable Luxury Home," Meg will share her journey to becoming an interior designer, her experiences on television, how to create your own livable home, and most importantly, avoiding "design crimes!" She will also discuss her latest project, a show on The Design Network, "Welcome Home Angel," which is based on her work as President of the nonprofit with the same name that transforms homes for children with special needs or who are medically fragile.

Inspired Design: Flowers in the French Style

Laura Dowling, author, speaker, designer, and former Chief Floral Designer at the White House from 2009 – 2015, will present an inspiring design program featuring her signature style floral tips and techniques, as well as share behind-the-scenes stories about her White House tenure. Laura most recently published "Bouquets: with How-to Tutorials," in which she describes the philosophy and process for making exquisite garden style bouquets using lush and vibrant seasonal blooms. She believes that bouquets, the most personal and evocative form of floristry, have the potential to convey a vast range of emotions and meanings that words alone cannot express, unlocking a powerful tool for uplifting spirits, telling stories and enriching our lives. In this A+M program, Laura will share ideas for creating natural décor for the fall and winter season, including bouquets, wreaths and centerpieces, along with her sources of inspiration – especially her passion for French design and her White House experience.
