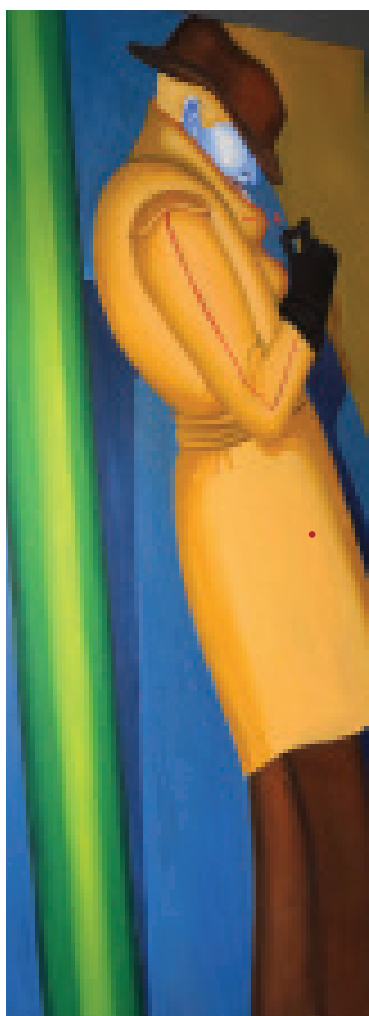

Esteemed designer Tom Stringer, founder of Chicago-based Tom Stringer Design Partners, will discuss his book *An Adventurous Life* with Laura Hine, Editor-in-Chief of *Interiors Chicago* magazine.
