Esteemed designer Tom Stringer, founder of Chicago-based Tom Stringer Design Partners, will discuss his book An Adventurous Life with Laura Hine, Editor-in-Chief of Interiors Chicago magazine. Tom and Laura will converse about how Tom uses magical discoveries made on his global travels to create the most special living environments that are true to his clients' own personalities and passions.
