Statement of Values and Principles (What we Believe) :

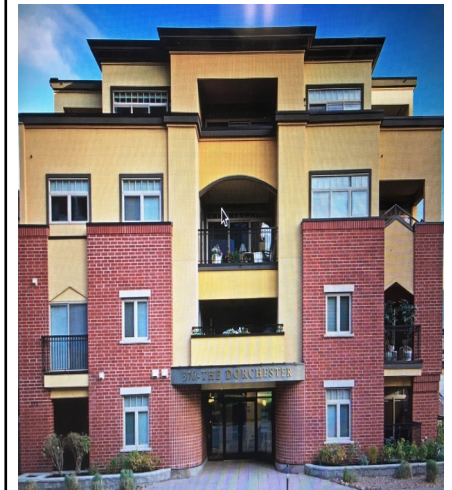
- We all have the same rights and responsibilities

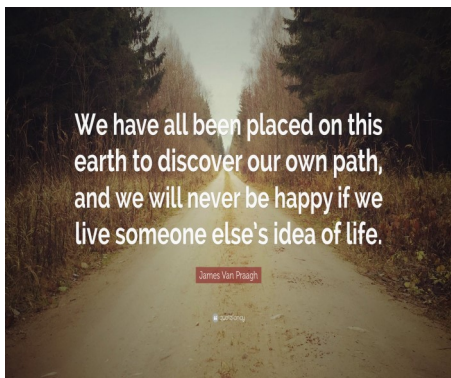
