

# About Consent

1. Sometimes the employees, volunteers and contractors working for It's My Life Kamloops Society need to share information about you, as well as other external professionals and CLBC.
2. We do this so that you get good care and support.
3. Sometimes It's My Life Kamloops Society employees need to share information with other people about you.
4. Consent means that you say it is okay for It's My Life Kamloops Society to share information with the people you choose on the list.
5. This consent form is good for one year but if something changes in your life, you can do a new form at any time. You can change your mind about giving consent. If you change your mind you need to write this down and give it to us.
6. There is some information the law says we must share without your consent.  
This includes any information about:
  - Abuse (this means hurting someone else or hurting yourself).
  - Neglect (this means not taking care of yourself or someone else).
  - Suicide Threats (this means saying you will hurt yourself or take your own life).
  - Breaking the Law (this means saying you plan to break the law or telling us you did break the law).
  - Subpoenaed Information (this means a judge has given us a court order to share information).
7. It's My Life Kamloops Society only shares information written by It's My Life Kamloops Society staff. We cannot share information written by other people.
8. It's My Life Kamloops Society also shares information about your skills, talents, abilities and dreams when we think it will help you get what you want out of life.

9. When you agree to receive our services, you agree to sharing information about the services you receive with our funders. They help to make sure your services meet the required standards.
