

Evacuation Plans for the RM of Paddockwood Candle Lake Area

In the event of an evacuation, we have compiled all necessary information to ensure a smooth and organized departure for all residents of the RM of Paddockwood. Here's what you need to know:

IF YOU REQUIRE ASSISTANCE AFTER EVACUATION SUCH AS LODGINGS PLEASE NOTIFY THE RM NOW SO WE CAN PRE-PLAN WITH SPSA.

IF YOU HAVE AN RV AND ARE ABLE TO GET IT OUT AND PLACED SOMEWHERE SAFE PLEASE CONSIDER THIS. DUE TO THE EVACUATIONS THROUGHOUT THE PROVINCE ANY LODGING AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME WILL NOT BE IN THE AREA.

Notification Process

- **Door-to-Door Alerts:** In the event of an evacuation order, our team will go door-to-door to make sure everyone is aware and informed.
- **Advance Notice:** The Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency (SPSA) will make every attempt to provide 48 hours' notice before a full evacuation order is required but circumstances can change and this may not always be possible. Be prepared to act quickly if necessary.
- **Initial Alert:** Please be advised that the initial evacuation alert will be initiated via SaskAlert to ensure timely and widespread notification. Updates will be made available on our website and Facebook page following the SaskAlert notification.

Evacuation Procedure

- 1. **Registration:** When you evacuate, please register with the volunteers stationed at the entrance to Cranberry Creek/Aschim Homestead. This ensures we maintain an accurate headcount and can assist those in need. If you evacuate prior to the volunteers being in place please let the RM know by phone or email or the Evacuation App on the SPSA website.
- 2. **Pre-Evacuation Registration:** If you decide to evacuate before an official order is issued, please register with the RM office. You can do this:
 - Via the "Contact Us" page on our website

 - Contact the RM office at 306-989-2124 please leave a message if you are unable to get through on the main line.
- 3. **Emergency Management Contact:** Our Emergency Management Organization (EMO) Coordinator, Chris McShannock, is available to answer any questions or concerns you may have during this time.

- **Stay Informed:** Keep an eye on local news outlets and official RM channels for updates regarding the situation. Download the SaskAlert App to your phone and add RM of Paddockwood to your locations.
- **Plan Ahead:** Make sure you have your essentials ready for a quick departure, including important documents, medications, and emergency supplies.
- **Community Support:** Look out for your neighbors and assist those who may need extra help during the evacuation process.
