**1/ Rubbing down of antifouling is not permitted during the last two weeks of any individual lift period.**

**This is to avoid contamination of other boats that have progressed past that stage.**

**2/ Grinding of any metal in the vicinity of other boats is strictly prohibited at all times.**

**3/ Welding in the vicinity of other boats is strictly prohibited unless fully shielded by heat resistant sheets.**

**4/ Applying paint (or antifouling) by means of compressed air spray is strictly prohibited at all times.**

Previous experience shows that even extensive shielding with plastic sheets does not fully prevent paint droplets from drifting onto adjacent boats.

**5/ Leaving any electrical equipment plugged into the club's mains supply over night or unattended for long periods is strictly forbidden by order of the committee (Nov 2013). Any member finding anything plugged in under these circumstances is instructed to unplug it.**

**6/ All participating skippers are required to attend and assist at the final clear up day (20<sup>th</sup> April)**
